

HONORING The Two C.F.A. Judges Emeriti

Mrs. Marguerite Saxby Mabie, has held about every position available in CFA. She purchased her first Silver Persian in 1922, when she joined the Boston Cat Club, of which she became President for ten years. Her first Judging assignment was in 1933, then she served on the CFA Executive Board from 1944 to 1963, when she retired. While President of CFA, from 1951 to 1956, she organized the Judging Program, and was Chairman of this for two years. When she and husband Ralph moved to Florida she joined the Miami Florida

Cat Club and remained to serve as President for five years. In 1959 she organized the Gold Coast Club of Florida, and was President of it for six years. Mrs. Mabie did not shirk work of any kind, for she was Show Manager for the B.C.C. and the M.F. C.C. several times. Her cattery, Saxby, was well known for her excellent Silver Champions. "Do you enjoy the Fancy?" we asked her, and she replied, "Belonging to and being a part of the Fancy has been a most rewarding experience; my life indeed has been constantly enriched by it." Mrs. John H. Revington had been judging eighteen years when she judged the first Houston Cat Club sixteen years ago in 1951. She has bred her famous Dixi-Land Blue Persians since 1922 and her White Persians since 1936. She served on the CFA Board from 1954 until 1958, when she was again returned to the Board as Regional Vice President. Before retiring she was an active member of the CFA Judges Association. She has been considered an authority on the White and the Blue Persian, and her bloodlines have been used

to improve them all over the world. Her Gr. Ch. Dixi-Land's White Historian was truly history making, having been the offspring of a white and blue mating, showing the way to many breeders of the future; that White can be bred to Blue for type.
