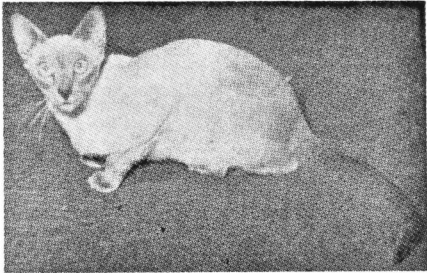


The DiNapoli Blue-Pointed Siamese
