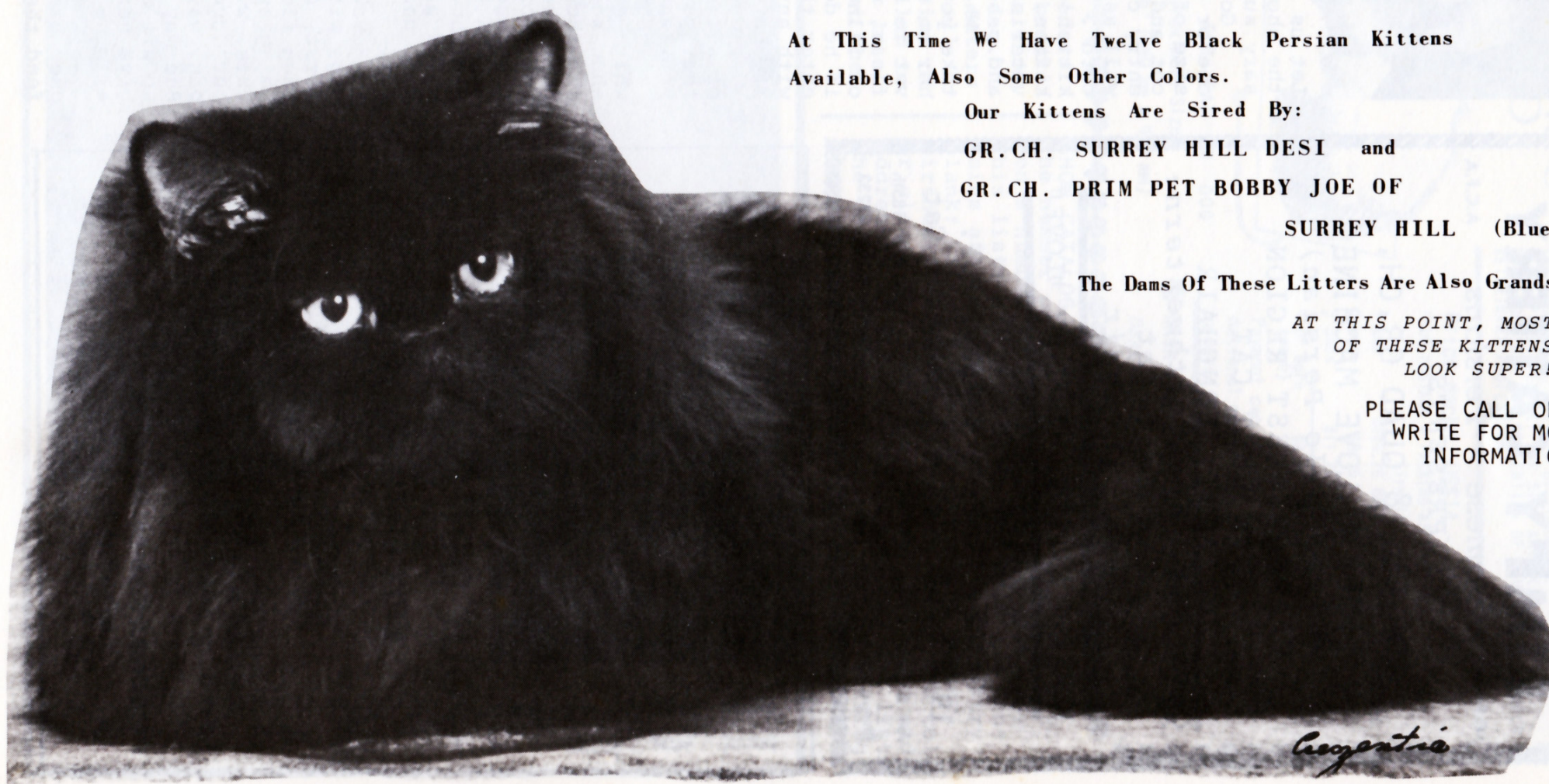

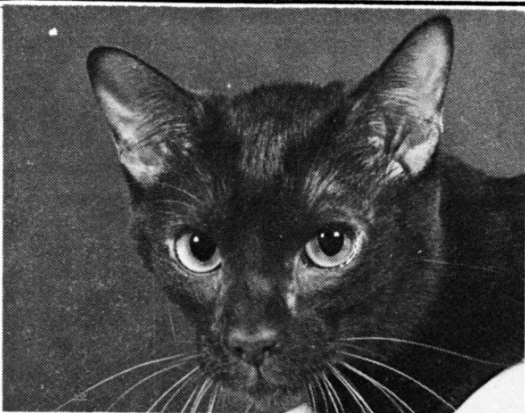

## "How to..."

### 3... Show Your Kitten (Part 1)

Let us assume that you have just arrived at the show-room with your kitten and the necessary supplies for the show.

Go straight to the vetting-in line where one or more veterinarians (depending on the size of the show) will be inspecting every cat and kitten. Usually the show secretary or entry clerk will be beside the vet table and will ask your name, then give you your "vet card". This card will list your name, your kitten's name, the designated number for your kitten, and there will be a space for the veterinarian's initial after he has checked and passed the kitten.

When you reach the front of the line, take your kitten from the carrier and place her on the table, holding her firmly, for the vet to look at her eyes and ears, check for fleas, ear-mites, skin disease, or any signs of illness. The vet's decision is final and if he decides that any entry is not fit to enter the show, it will be disqualified along with any other cats or kittens that the owner may have entered, be agenting or showing for a friend. This caution is for the protection of all other cats in the show. Do be sure that your kitten is in top condition before you leave for the show.

Some shows are the "Non-Vetted" type, in which case, you would get your card from the show secretary or entry clerk as you enter the show-room.

When your kitten has passed the vet inspection and the card has been signed, go to the cage that bears the same number as the one on the vet card. Usually a floor plan of the show-room is available and you can see in which area your kitten's cage is located. If not, one of the show committee will direct you.

Now you are almost ready to set up your cage with the pretty drapes you prepared but, first, clean the inside of the cage and the cage floor with a sponge and disingectant, being sure to use the type that is safe for cats. Wipe the area dry, then hang the drapes, put down the floor covering, add the litter-pan, water dish and, finally, your kitten. She may be confused and frightened at first, so sit and talk to her for awhile and maybe give her a cat-toy. She will soon adjust to all the strange sights and sounds.

The question of feeding a kitten at a show has many aspects. Most longhair breeders feed their kittens before the show and often

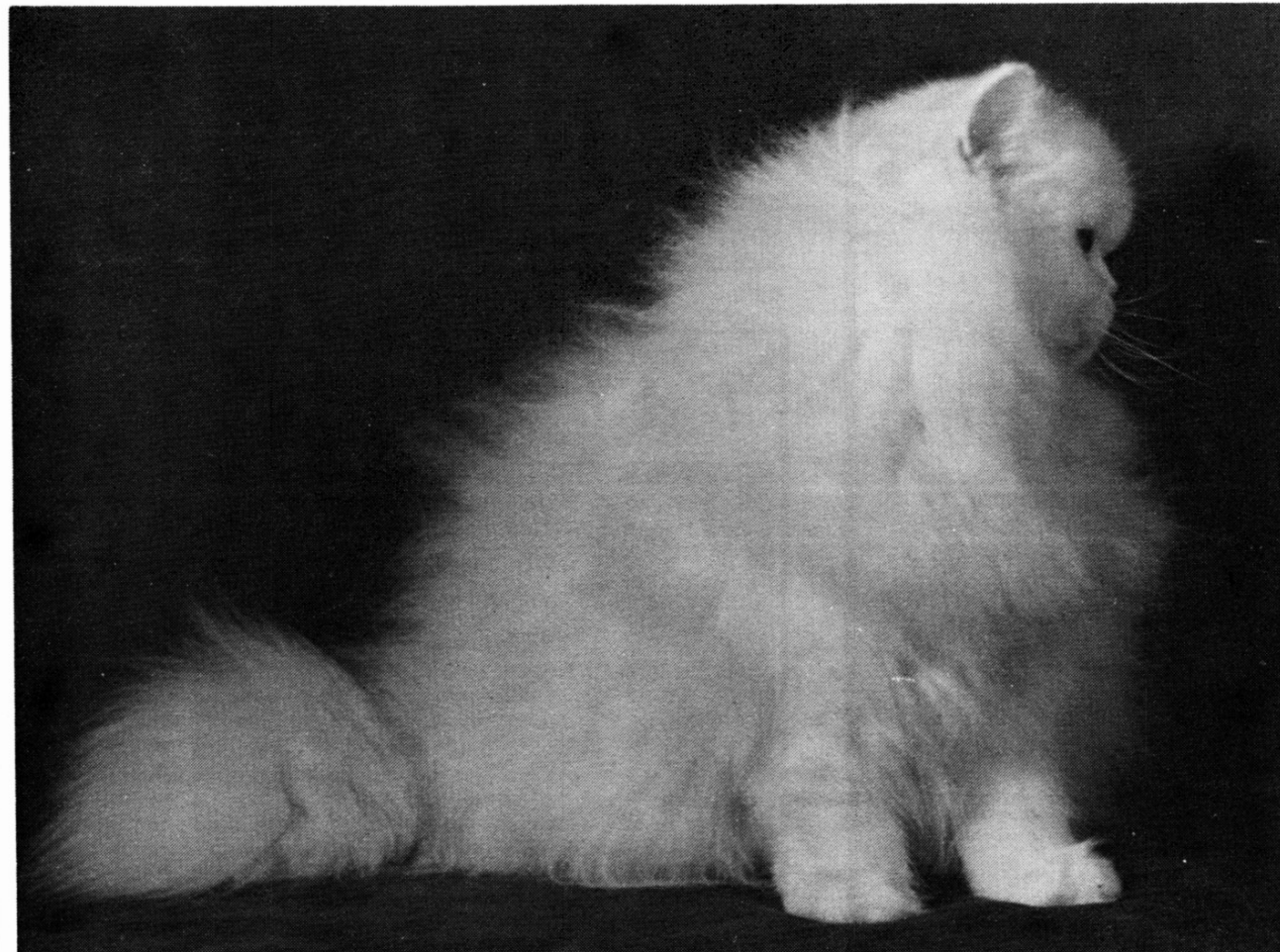

during the day, too. Most shorthair breeders feel differently and feed a very light breakfast before the show, nothing during the show, but give a good meal at the end of the day. Many of the shorthair breeds are great eaters and will gobble food if allowed to eat all they want, ending up with a bulge the size of a tennis ball just as the kitten is called to the judging ring!! Usually, it is best to feed lightly at the show, no matter what the breed.

### SHOW CATALOG

The number on the vet card is also the kitten's number in the official show catalog. This lists all entries in the show and contains all information you gave on the entry blank: kitten's name, registration number, birthdate, sire, dam, breeder, owner and color class. The front page shows the names and addresses of the officiating judges and lists the show officials. Elsewhere in the catalog the exhibitors' names and addresses are list-

ed in alphabetical order along with the numbers of their entries.

All Kitten entries are listed first in the catalog, with the longhaired breeds preceding the shorthairs. Next come the Championship classes, longhair and shorthair, the Premiership classes, longhair and shorthair, and then the ever-popular Household Pet classes. Premiership classes are for the 'altered' registered cats which, if unaltered, could compete in the Championship classes.

Buy a catalog (they are usually available from the entry clerk when you vet-in) and check in the kitten section to see that your entry's name, birthdate, registration number, breeder and owner are correct. If the information is not EXACTLY as shown on your CFA re-

gistration certificate, immediately inform the show secretary and master clerk and give them the corrections. Check also to see that the kitten is entered in the correct color class and as the right sex.

Find the "Judging Schedule" in your catalog. This is a list of the proposed order of judging and is intended as a guide for exhibitors so that they may prepare their cats well in advance for the judging in each ring. However, bear in mind that the schedule is subject to change by announcement.

If you are attending a one-day show with four judges, you are going to be busy as the kitten will be judged four times in one day. If it is a two-day show, then, usually, the kittens will be judged twice on Saturday and twice on Sunday. However, there is no hard and fast rule for kittens and they may be judged three times on Saturday and once on Sunday, or any other arrangement the show committee wishes to make. So check the schedule and see in which rings your kitten will be judged and when. Watch carefully the progress in those rings. If you find it confusing, don't hesitate to ask one of your fellow exhibitors; most are anxious to help newcomers. (Part 2 - 'Judging Begins' - next issue).

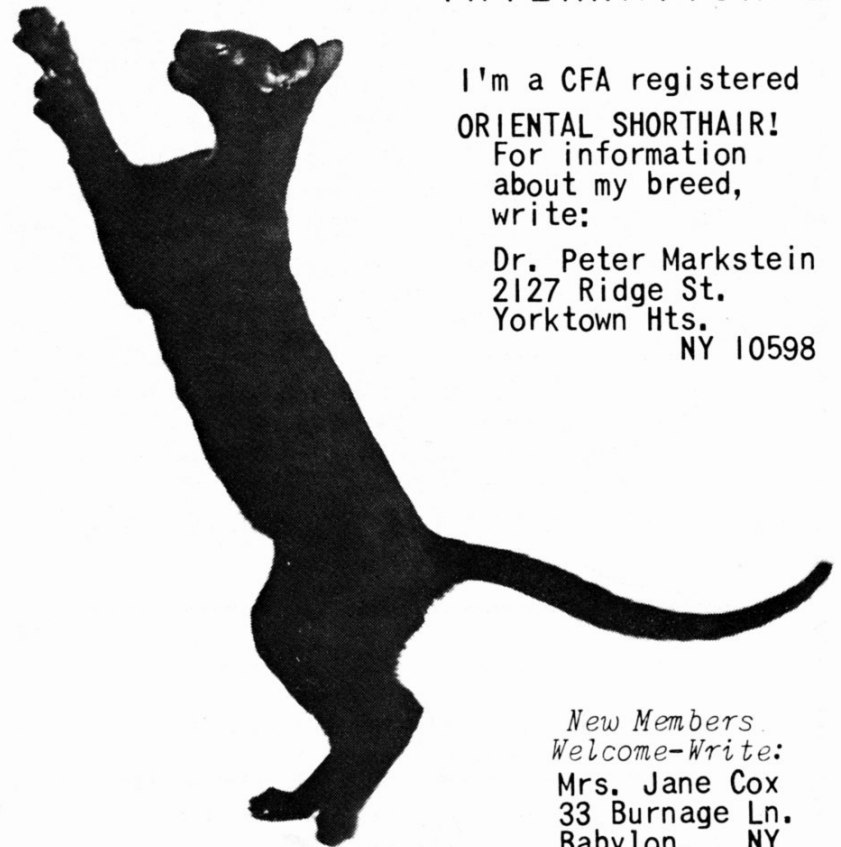

## NUTRITION PART 2

### MINERALS

The diet does not stop with protein, fat and carbohydrate. Minerals and vitamins must be provided.

Minerals are essential in the cat's diet and among these are sodium chloride, potassium, calcium, phosphorus, copper, iron and iodine.

Diets which are deficient in calcium and iodine will ultimately produce paralysis of the hind legs, and thinning of the bones occurs. The thyroid gland enlarges. Such signs occur in cats that are fed a total meat diet. When calcium is provided, skeletal changes, as described, will be prevented and, interestingly enough, calcium will also prevent some of the thyroid changes. Apparently there is synergistic relationship that is, in a sense, a complementary relationship in regard to calcium and iodine.

Calcium deficiency is perhaps the most common deficiency seen. This occurs because breeders very carefully remove all bone from the cat's diet. Bones, of course, are the best source of calcium. If you are afraid of bones, then add calcium carbonate to the diet or consider the fact that 3½ oz. of cow's milk will provide half of the daily requirement of calcium. Calcium carbonate may be added in the amount of 0.5 gm. to every 100 gms. (wet weight) of meat. Bone is preferable because it will provide some of the trace minerals.

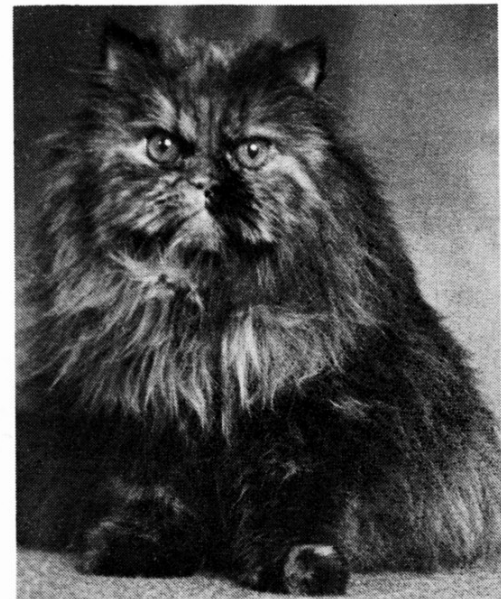

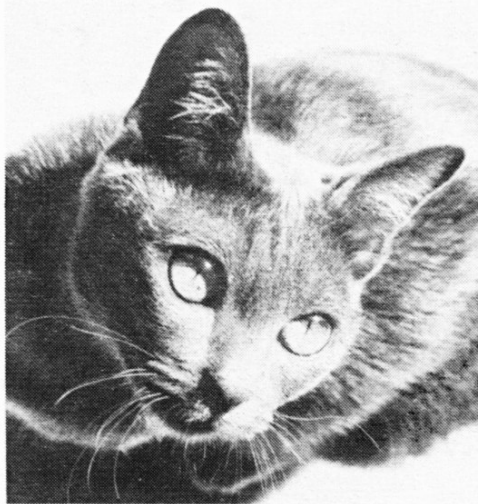

will consider very briefly first the fat soluble vitamins A, D, E and K.

## VITAMIN A

The daily requirement of vitamin A is 1000 to 2000 international units, and it should be pointed out that vitamin A is very susceptible to loss in processing. Therefore the amount of vitamin A recorded on food labels may be suspect. It might be worthwhile to mention some of the common foods which are sources of vitamin A: *whole milk, raw eggs, liver, butter and margarine.*

Cats that are deficient in vitamin A start to lose their appetites, eat poorly, become emaciated and develop weakness in the hind legs. These cats frequently develop bronchopneumonia and die. On the other hand, cats that receive too much vitamin A develop musculo-skeletal deformities that can cripple. Cats that eat large amounts of liver may develop hypervitaminosis A, but it is worthwhile to give some liver on a weekly basis.

## VITAMIN D

Young cats deficient in vitamin D can develop rickets. However, past the age of about 1½ years they need minimal amounts of vitamin D.

## VITAMIN E

Like vitamin A, vitamin E is also easily lost by processing. Diets that contain large quantities of tuna oil and/or cod liver oil require vitamin E to prevent steatitis. Daily requirement is 0.4 to 4.0 mg.

## VITAMIN K

No disease has been thus far described which has been attributed to vitamin K deficiency.

The following water soluble vitamins are important in the cat's diet:

### CHOLINE (100 mg.)

If the diet is deficient in choline, the cat will lose weight and pathologic signs of malnutrition such as decreased serum albumin and fatty liver develop.

### NIACIN (Nicotinic acid) (2.6-4.0 mg.)

Niacin deficiency produces diarrhea; emaciation; ulcerative mouth lesions; beefy red tongue; thick, foul smelling saliva; and ultimately death.

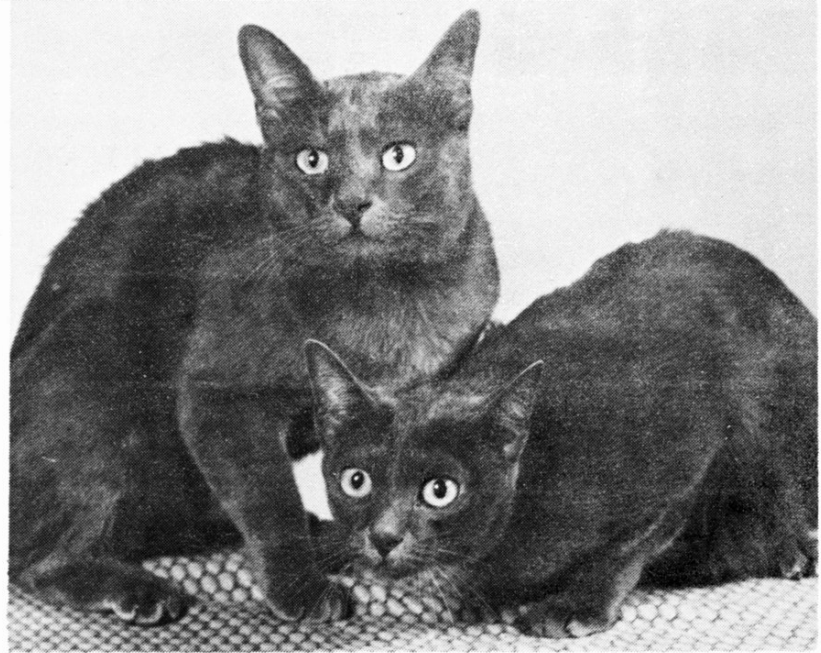

PANTOTHENIC ACID (0.25-1.0 mg.)

Deficiency produces weight loss and fatty liver.

RIBOFLAVIN (B2) (0.15-0.2 mg.)

Riboflavin must be increased when the queen is nursing or in any cat with fever. Again, cats will lose weight and ultimately die.

THIAMIN (B1) (0.2-1.0 mg.)

Deficiency is characterized by anorexia, vomiting, ataxia, abnormal reflexes, seizures, and cardiac disorders. Thiamin must be increased in lactation and fever.

VITAMIN B6 (Pyridoxine)

Deficiency is characterized by failure to grow, emaciation, anemia, seizures and kidney disease.

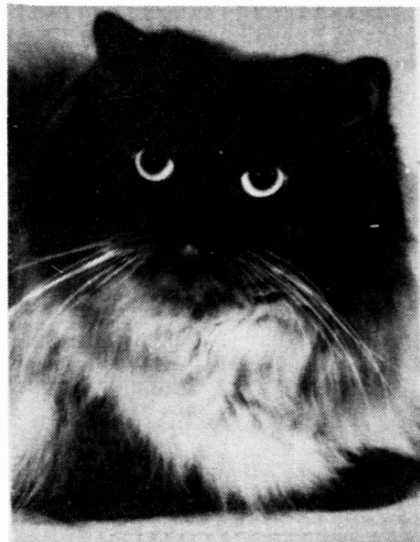
As you can see, the majority of conditions associated with vitamin deficiency begin with loss of appetite and weight loss. These two signals should certainly alert the conscientious breeder to have his cat or kitten checked for disease and/or parasitic infestation. If nothing is found, it would

seem worthwhile to change the animal's diet.

EVERYDAY FEEDING

You have seen what the cat should have in its diet at various stages of life. You have seen the amounts, that is, the numbers of calories and minerals and vitamins required to maintain health and development. How does one translate all of this into the everyday business of feeding cats?

If you rely on commercial cat food alone you should pause to consider what was put in those cans. What quality of protein has been processed? How much of the nutrient value has been destroyed by processing? How long has the can been on the shelf in the supermarket? What toxic agents have found their way into the can? What has happened to the vitamins added to the product? These are questions you should think about, particularly if your cat seems a bit puny or if she fails to conceive as you think she should, or if your male cat is sterile. (To next page)

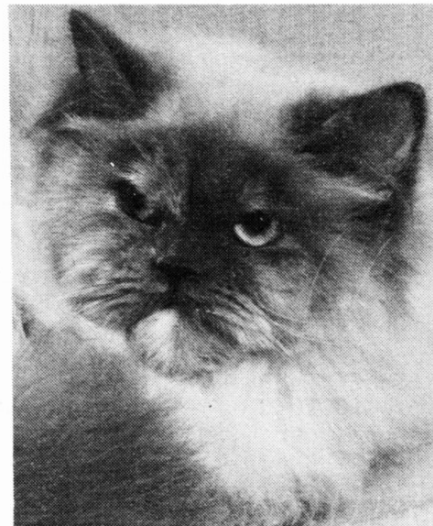

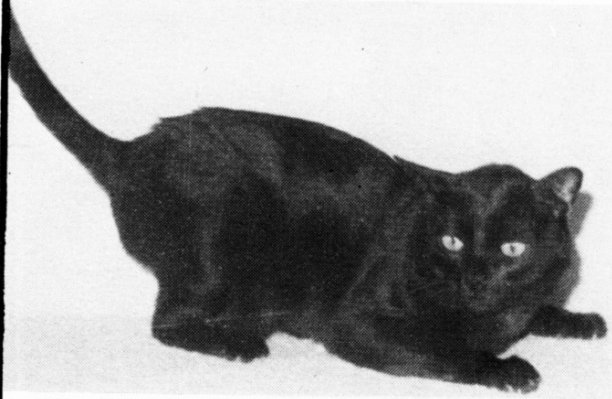

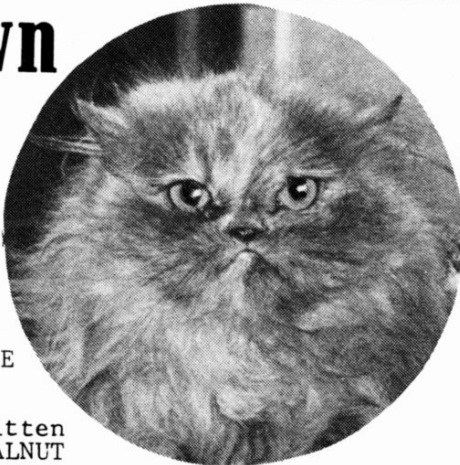

The quality of food you put into your cat shows, make no mistake about it. "Peltz's Law" states that the amount of your veterinary bill is in direct proportion to the quality of food fed your cats. For well nourished cats are less prone to infections and require less veterinary care.

I realize that many breeders feed their cats once a day. I prefer two meals a day for the adult cat, four meals a day for kittens and four meals for the nursing queen.

The diet should be varied and include: hamburger, beef stew, chicken, turkey, heart, kidney, liver, mackerel, milk, cottage cheese butter, egg yolk, cooked potato, cooked rice or cereal.

Let's start with the weaning kitten. If the litter is large, it is necessary to supplement early, perhaps even as early as the first week. It's worthwhile to keep Esbilac or KMR on hand for this purpose. To start the process begin bottle feeding KMR and gradually add strained meat to the KMR, feed in a bottle or eye dropper and then progress to fingertip feeding of strained meat and then to the saucer. Some kittens will progress faster than others. At about 5 to 6 weeks, start cottage cheese, ground meat, added vitamins and minerals. Continue KMR or some other formula of your choosing.

I think it is important to get kittens addicted to strained baby meat for they remember the taste for the rest of their lives and that fact comes in mighty handy when you have to feed the sick cat.

When you've reached the saucer stage, I feed mother and kittens together. She is a good teacher provided you don't have a kitten who insists on nursing while mother is eating.

The young cat is gradually led through a series of declining numbers of feedings from 4 to 3 to 2 a day.

I feel that vitamins should be added to most food for the cat and, need it be said, that ample fresh water should be available at all times. You might add extra salt to the food as it encourages fluid intake.

Whether or not you feed a variety of meat, poultry, fish and milk products is a matter of personal choice. Perhaps you have been successful with a strictly canned food regimen. Use the diet that has been most successful for you.

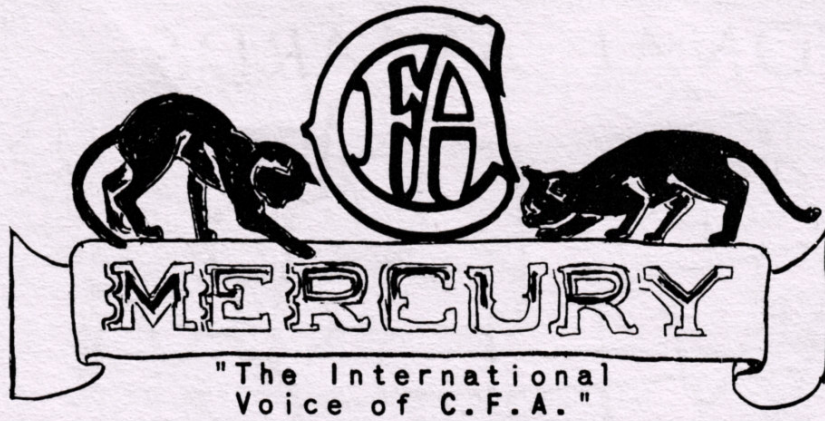
## FEEDING PROBLEMS

Perhaps one of the great problems is the geriatric cat, the cat that has been a part of our lives for years. It seems that these cats try frantically to eat a regular diet but cry pitifully and begin to fade away. The geriatric cat requires about 4 or 5 oz. of food a day. It is preferable to offer several small meals - very soft cottage cheese or minced kidney, milk, pureed chicken, etc. This cat must be fed alone and given ample time to complete each meal.

The sick cat is really a feeding chal-

### LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE

This Committee works with the CFA Attorney when it is felt that action is needed with respect to pending Federal legislation concerning cats and CFA people. State and Local legislation presents a different problem: laws, regulations, ordinances and rules can be so different from state to state and from city to county to township, that it is usually best to work for or against them at the local level by local people. In the event a local or state situation appears to be of such a scale that the local clubs believe CFA may be of assistance, Barbara St. Georges, Committee Chairman, should be contacted.

JANE MARTINKE FELINE REFERENCE CENTER  
Rosemonde Peltz, Committee Chairman, reported plans to expand the work of her committee by forming the JANE MARTINKE FELINE REFERENCE CENTER. This center will promote communication between the veterinary research scientist and the breeder, something that has been lacking in the past. Two subcommittees will form the center: one composed of CFA breeders, the other of veterinary research scientists. In addition to information exchange for mutual benefit, there will be divisions concerned with specific scientific areas and with cattery environment. Several noted scientists have assured Dr. Peltz of their willingness to cooperate.

Details of how Dr. Peltz's committee will move ahead on this exciting plan will be published in this section. There should be many interesting assignments available for breeders who are willing to work hard in this program, and many benefits for our cats as the lines of communication are established and the work progresses. Dr. Peltz is promoting a real step forward for CFA progress in research aid to the breeder.

### CFA NATIONAL CAT SHOW

This subject will be studied by a committee chaired by Barbara St. Georges and various alternatives for a fair and representative competition between the top CFA cats will be investigated. One approach is to qualify entrants for the national show by holding a show in each region to pick the best cats to move onward. I have been appointed to this committee and my first interest lies in ways to organize a fair and consistent format for the Regional shows. Anyone who has ideas for consideration is invited to send them to me (Old Carriage Road, Glenarm, MD 21057).

### CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AND RESOLUTIONS

The complete text of the proposals was contained in the CFA Quarterly, Summer, 1975. Numbers 1, 2, 3, 7, 8 and 9 of the proposed constitutional amendments were adopted; number 6 was defeated; and numbers 4 and 5 are to be rewritten and resubmitted. Of the proposed resolutions, numbers 13, 14 and 24 received favorable recommendation, number 23 was withdrawn, and the remainder received unfavorable recommendations. Two resolutions from the floor got favorable recommendations: (a) to give 4th and 5th in Premiership in Specialty rings; (b) to close the ASH registry. Three others---to redefine the Novice and Open classes and to move the Cameo Persians to the Smoke Division---received unfavorable recommendations.

### NEXT ANNUAL - AN OFFICIAL BICENTENNIAL EVENT

The 1976 CFA Annual has been designated an Official Bicentennial Event. An historic "Bennington" flag was presented to President Gebhardt; this will remain in the CFA office until the Annual to be held June 24 through 27, 1976, at the Shoreham Hotel, Washington, D.C.###

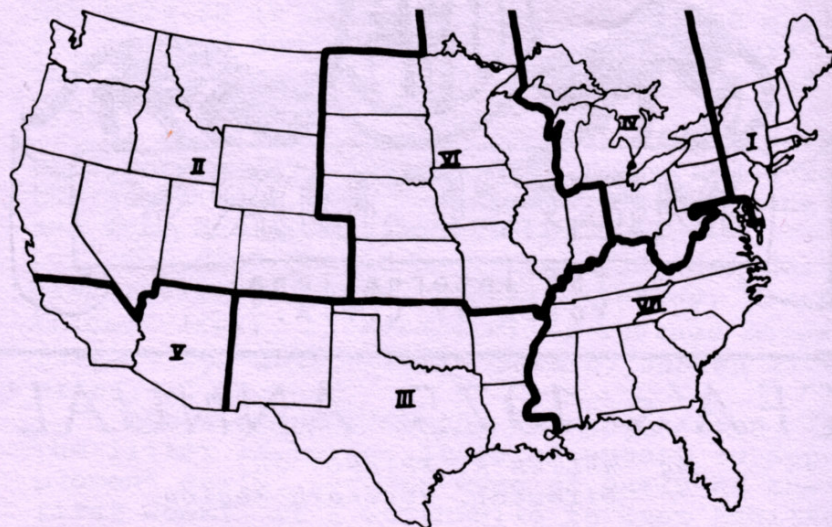


# 1974-'75 REGIONAL AWARDS

Cat Fanciers Association is divided into seven Regions (see map). Each Region runs its own Regional Awards program especially for cats resident in that Region: this is completely independent of the CFA National scoring program. An official scorer in each Region tabulates points earned at shows in the Region by its feline residents.

In the National scoring, every cat's achievements in any CFA show in the country earn points toward National awards. However, in the Regional scoring, the cat must earn its points in its Region of residence. For example, points earned by a cat who resides in the Midwest Region at a show held in the Gulf Shore Region would count towards a National award but not toward a Regional one. To accumulate points toward a Midwest Region award, the cat would have to earn his points at Midwest Region shows; he would not be eligible for an award in the Gulf Shore Region.

This explains why a cat who finishes the season with such a high point score that he becomes a member of the National Top 20 might be lower down the ladder in the awards of his own Region. An example would be *GR.CH. VELVA'S COBALT BARON OF TSAR BLU*, a Russian Blue resident of the Northwest Region. He was National #8 Cat but was 12th in the Northwest Regional Awards. The large point cat he won during the 1974/'75 season was principally accumulated at shows outside the boundaries of the Northwest Region.



## COMPARATIVE CHARTS

In the following charts, exhibitors will be able to readily compare the top cats of each Region position-by-position with those of the other six Regions.

Information for these charts was furnished by each Region and, as each one presents its results slightly differently, this analysis is not entirely uniform. Regions 3 and 5 do not indicate Championship status of their winners while Region 4 does not include sex. It will, of course, be realized that Region 3 and 5 winners certainly have titles, many of them Grand Championships.

# College Of Cat Genetics

## STUDY UNIT 12

### GENES IN ACTION

Genes are not simply separate elements controlling individual effects. In fact they work with each other and with the cats environment in a variety of ways. There are no genes individually responsible for characters such as undershot jaw, thick tails, etc., although it is true that, in many cases, character such as coat colour may be affected to a greater degree by one particular gene. In such circumstances, the gene is named for the effect it produces but it should be remembered that it may well have other perhaps less noticeable effects. Any one character is affected by a number of genes and its final phenotype is dictated by the way in which the genes work together and with the environment.

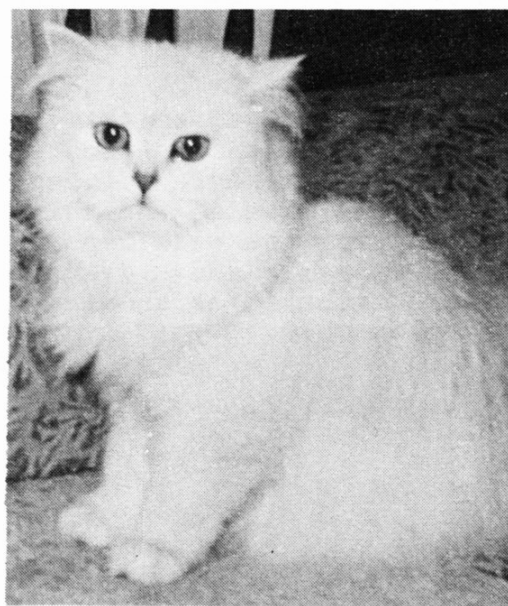
When two gene pairs, each having two alleles, are segregating independently, the consequences are easily predicted. As has been shown, a cross between heterozygotes for both pairs will give kits of nine genotypes, i.e.  $D/d.r+r \times D/d.r+r = 1/16 D/D.r+/r+; 2/16 D/D.r.r+; 2/16 d/D.r+/r+; 4/16 d/D.r.r+; 1/16 D/D.r/r; 2/16 d/D.r/r; 1/16 d/d.r+/r+; 2/16 d/d.r.r+; 1/16 d/d.r/r$ . All the while assortment at each gene pair is independent of the other and the existence of the genotypes not impaired by lethals then the above ratios will hold true for all crosses. However, genotype ratios can only be assessed by phenotype ra-

tios unless programmes of test matings are undertaken with all those cats owning genotypes in question. It is only the phenotype that is seen and it is because some of the different genotypes show similar phenotypes that the ratios of the second do not always reflect those of the first. In the case of complete dominance the phenotype ratio of progeny from such a mating as that described above is 9 Black Non Rex; 3 Black Rex; 3 Blue Non Rex; 1 Blue Rex, i.e. 9:3:3:1.

Most of the crosses so far demonstrated have been with cats homozygous and heterozygous for alleles proved to act as simple dominants. In simple of complete dominance the heterozygote, although genotypically different, appears identical in phenotype as one of the two homozygotes, i.e.  $a/A = A/A$ . The presence of the recessive gene is hidden. Any

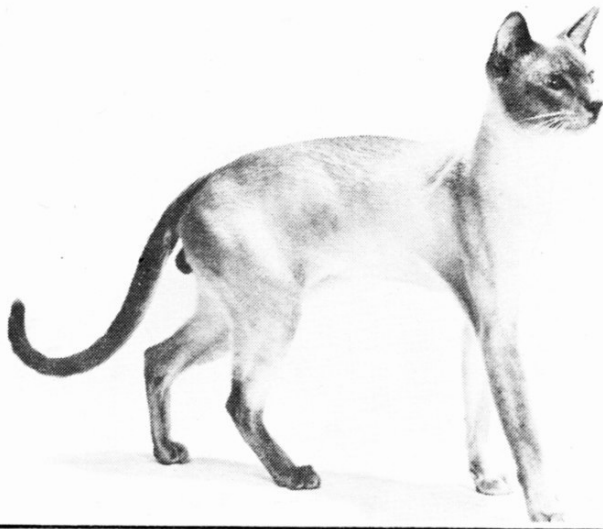

lesser effect in the phenotype of the heterozygote towards the recessive alternative can be accounted for by partial or incomplete dominance.

Incomplete dominance seems to be the rule throughout the albino series, the chinchilla or silver/burmese hybrid has been demonstrated as a phenotype showing characteristics intermediate to these alleles. There also seems ground for the opinion that there may be incomplete dominance between chinchilla (or silver) and siamese and this could perhaps account for the cats reported in gene surveys by A.G. Searle and B.J. Marples. These cats are reported as showing faint tabby pattern on the body but a darker one on the extremities and are regarded by Searle to be different from Siamese dilution. As their eye colour is unknown they could, of course, be tabby burmese but incomplete dominance would account for the cat in the possession of the author whose genotype combines chinchilla/silver and siamese. This cat is simi-

lar in phenotype to the White or Chinchilla Tiger with muted tabby pattern on an off-white ground and blue eyes.

There are many types of interaction between genes of different loci, one of these can be seen in the way that variations in the blue eye colour of the Siamese are caused by the presence or absence of brown or dilution, etc., in the genotype. Other genes mimic each other, similar phenotypes complementing each other's action, so that crosses between them give normal wild type progeny.

If one gene is epistatic to the other then the resultant ratio is different again. Epistasis is a type of interaction between non allelic genes where the presence of a gene at one locus prevents the expression of that at another. Examples in cats are seen where the non agouti mutant such as the blue or black masks the expression of, and is thus epistatic to, the tabby alleles, so that except for ghost markings in kittens the actual patterns cannot be seen. Fanciers normally

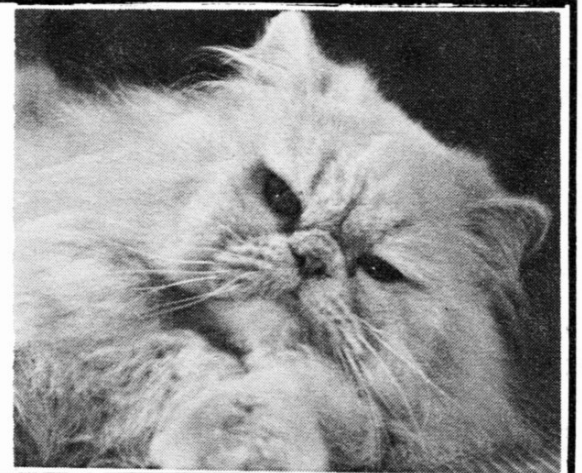

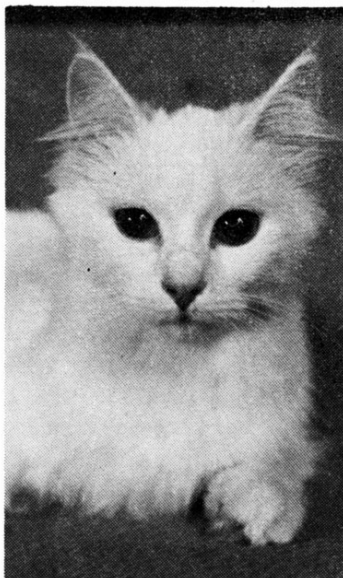

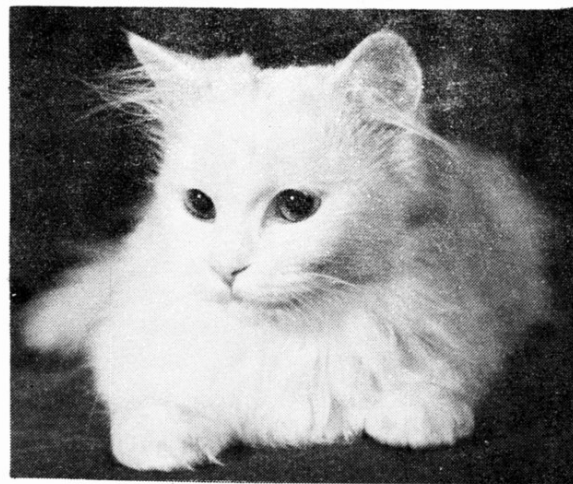

use the word tabby to describe the combined effect of the genes for agouti and tabby patterning but, technically, tabby is a word describing the patterns carried in the genotype of all cats, whether agouti or not. Agouti which controls hair banding also allows expression of the tabby alleles but the presence of homozygous recessive non-agouti prevents the expression of tabby pattern as well as that of hair banding at its own locus.

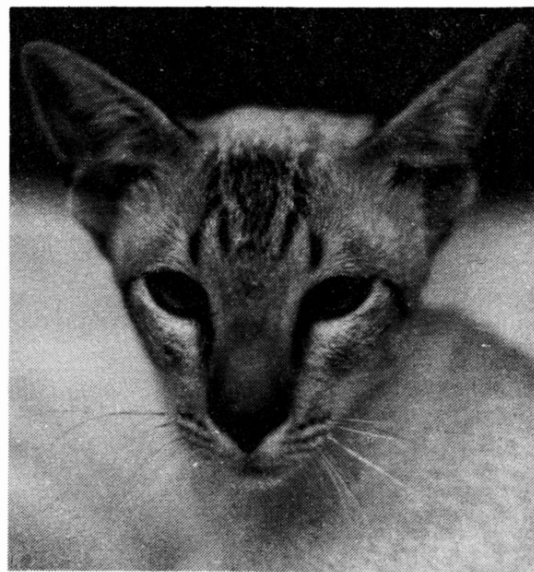
Orange (or red or yellow) masks the expression of non-agouti. Here then the tables are turned and even the non agouti cat will show tabby pattern if it is also orange. The effect of tabby pattern can be lessened by selection for the abyssinian allele but, nevertheless, it remains present. In this context, the word abyssinian describes the tabby pattern seen in the Abyssinian cat and not the breed itself. The epistasis of orange over non agouti accounts for the difficulties experienced in the breeding of "Self" Reds as while in the long haired varieties the pattern may be broken to a certain extent there are still noticeable tabby markings seen on the shorter hair of the head.

Sometimes genes are described as hypostatic, this condition being the exact opposite of epistatic much as recessive is the opposite to dominant. Thus tabby pattern is hypostatic to non agouti and non agouti is hypostatic to orange, etc. A proposed explanation for the inheritance of blue eyes in

The NATIONALS are no 'glittering glass' publicity gimmick, but the 'real McCoy', America's true 'diamond' awards event. A NATIONAL AWARD surrounds the cat with merited glory and brings great recognition to the owner and breeder. There's nothing quite like this CFA awards program in catdom.

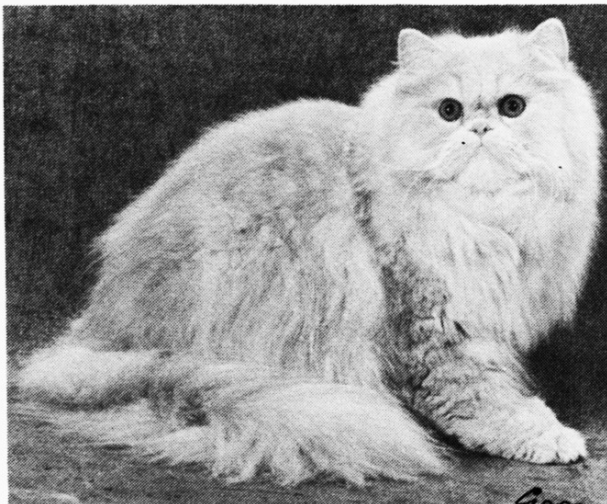
## SCORING

The C.F.A. NATIONAL AWARDS scheme was planned to properly spotlight the country's twenty adult cats who earned more points than their show peers during the season; the five best kittens; and the five Premiers who defeated the greatest number of altered cats at shows.

C.F.A. further recognizes the best cat of each breed or division, and the best cat of each color of breed, not represented in the top twenty cats. All winners in the NATIONALS earning over 150 points receive cash awards from the association.

Scoring is done by C.F.A.'s Central Office via computer. Every CFA-registered cat of a breed and color recognized for Championship is automatically scored each time entered in a C.F.A. show. This scoring is done completely without charge to breeder, owner or cat club. During the 1974-1975 season, CFA scored an entry of 46,195 cats over 188 shows!

## BEST CATS IN AMERICA

Nine Persians, four Burmese, three American Shorthairs, one Exotic Shorthair, one Himalayan, one Russian Blue and one Siamese, all Grand Champions, are included among the 1974/'75 season's TOP 20 C.F.A. NATIONAL AWARD WINNERS. Their leader is 2-year-old Black Persian male, *HAWTHORNE NITE LITER OF LEE*, who became a Grand in the preceding season.

Runnerup, *APACHE CHIEF MATEO*, 4-year-old Silver Tabby American Shorthair (ASH), makes his third consecutive appearance on this select list, previously placing third and sixth *ROCOCO RUBY PETUNIA*, Tortoiseshell ASH, Number 14 Cat, is also a three-timer placing third last year and thirteenth before.

Tortoiseshell Exotic Shorthair, *KALAMARS SWEET PEA OF SWANY*, Number 3 Cat, was CFA's Second Best Kitten in 1973/'74; and that season's Third Best Kitten, *TABBYLAND'S TROOPER*, Red Tabby Persian male, makes the Top 20 this year as Number 5 Cat.

*SURREY HILL DESI*, Black Persian male, ranked Number 6, completed his Grand during the 1973/'74 show season as did *MILLCREEK'S SILVER PRIZE*, Silver Tabby ASH male (Number 12 Cat), *WHEELER'S MARC OF Q-T CATS*, Blue Persian male (Number 13), and *JADON KARMEL SUNDAE*, Cream Persian female (Number 16).

*VELVA'S COBALT BARON OF TSAR BLU*, Russian Blue male, youngest cat on the list, won a 'triple crown' last season: his Grand Championship, Number 4 Kitten and Number 8 cat! Other brand-new Grands to win acclaim are: Number 4--Burmese male, *KEMLIN CHANGO*, son of *GR.CH. KEMLIN KEOWEE*, 1974 CFA Top Cat; Number 7--*CATLIN ARIADNE OF SANGAZURE*, Burmese female; Number 9--*ASTRA'S COTY*, Copper-Eyed White Persian female; Numbers 10 and 15--Cream Persian males *SANDEF'S BIG DAVE OF JENSEN* and *KILARNEY'S SHAMROCK OF Q-T CATS*; Number 18--*MUSIC MAN'S BEL CANTO*, Burmese female; Number 19--*JAMES CATINET BANJO*, Black Persian male; and Number 20--*ROGERS HTS. WILLA BET*, Seal Pt. Siamese female.

*NEVAH-TEP'S VOGUE*, Seal Point Himalayan female, was CFA's Best Himalayan of 1971/'72, a feat she has repeated this past season plus achieving the ultimate triumph of a position in the NATIONALS as Number 17 Cat. *VOGUE*, born March 16, 1970, is senior cat on the list, four months older than the Number 11 Cat, *TOK-LAT'S STANLEY OWEN BUCHANAN*, Burmese male. The honor list includes twelve males, eight females.

## OUTSTANDING KITTENS AND PREMIERS

CFA'S Top Kitten for 1974/'75 is *BRYN MAWR GEORGIE GIRL*, Blue Cream Persian, who competed in 16 shows as a kitten. She was named Best Kitten under 41 judges and 15 others put her in the Top 5. She went on to win her Grand at the age of only 8 months and 18 days. *SANDEF'S OH SUSANNA OF JENSEN*, Cream Persian female, is this season's runnerup.

*DOCIA-DAO SUPER COLOSSAL*, Blue Exotic SH female, and *WIL-O-ROSE HAPPY HOUR OF JOLEE*, Copper-Eyed White Persian male, third and

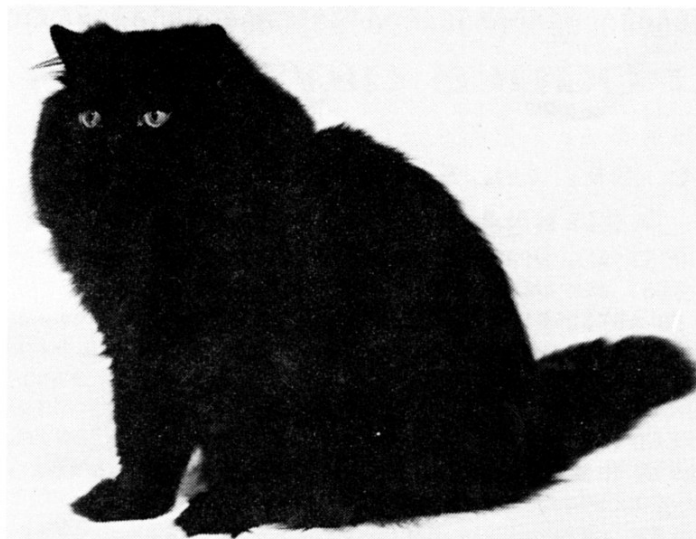

As Persian breeders, our main interest and efforts have been directed toward the bi-color and calico breeding program. For this reason, we needed a very good black male to use in our breeding program. We feel that it was fate's kind hand that led us to the purchase of *HAWTHORNE NITE LITER* when he was almost six months of age.

*NITE LITER* was shown in a few CFA shows as a kitten and, out of the 20 rings, he made 18 finals with 9 Best Kitten awards. His adult career in the last half of the 1974 show season was a thrill: the highlight was his All Breed Best Cat win at the CFA Lincoln State Cat Club show (Feb., 1974) as a Champion. He became a Grand at that show. *NITE LITER* that season was shown in only a few Great Lakes Region shows as an adult but, to our surprise, was 10th Best Cat in the Great Lakes Regional awards which encouraged us to show him for a full adult season.

## PAST SHOW SEASON

We entered him in the CFA Sacred Cat of Burma Fanciers show in June, 1974, and he took three Best Cats and one Second Best Cat. This was the start of a long show season which had many tense and emotional moments. It was a great thrill in February, 1975, at the CFA Wichita Cat Fancy show when *NITE LITER* went across the board as Best Cat. There were many other exciting times, and disappointments, too, but we never dreamed of finishing at the

top when the show season ended. Our original hope was for "Best Black" in the CFA NATIONAL AWARDS.

*NITE LITER*'s age during the show season was 15 to 25 months. From past experience, we have found that this is not a good age at which to show a male; in fact, we have found it is perhaps the worst time. The males often lose coat and weight and become interested in other pursuits. Fortunately, *NITE LITER* was different: he enjoyed and thrived upon the show scene. He improved steadily during the year and a judge at his final show (Fort Wayne Cat Fanciers, April 26 & 27, 1975) said he had never been better. This was a tremendous compliment after thirty-three shows. It was true that *NITE LITER* had enjoyed the traveling and showing. His calm personality and temperament made him a delight to present in the ring.

*NITE LITER* was shown in 33 CFA shows during the 1974-75 show season. He finished in the top five cats 112 out of 129 rings with 64 Best Cats. Fortyone different CFA judges put him in the top five.

## FIRST OFFSPRING

In May, 1974, *NITE LITER* was bred to his first female. We had no plans to show him further at that time. His first litter consisted of two females, a blue and a tortie. The blue, *LEE'S GRAMPA'S GIRL*, was shown in a few kitten shows and made several finals. The tortie, *LEE'S BLANCHETTE*, was shown in one kitten show and made finals. In this new show season, both have been to three shows, taking eight winners ribbons each and making finals in each show. However, they have an impossible task to perform if they intend to fill their daddy's shoes. *GRAMPA'S GIRL* is named after her daddy who is known as 'GRAMPA' at home.

We are thrilled to have been part of the life of such a lovely cat. For us, *NITE LITER*'s beauty is greatly enhanced by his loving and delightful personality. We have always said, from the time he was a kitten, that he was created in heaven and had a special purpose to his life. We now know what that special purpose was.###

For 1974 the mortality rate was 28.8% with the greatest numbers of deaths occurring in Siamese (1), Himalayan (2) and Persian (3).

Interestingly enough, diseases which attract a great deal of attention carried a low mortality rate in kittens and cats up to one year of age. Feline leukemia carried no greater mortality rate than accidental suffocation of kittens by their dam. In each category, the rate was 2.4%.



Birthrate and mortality were comparable for 1973 and 1974. Although stillbirths and death due to unknown cause rank in the top three causes of death, respiratory infections decreased from 20% to 7%.

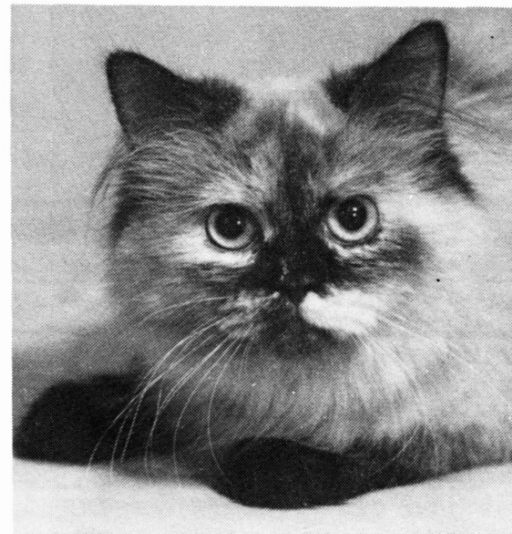

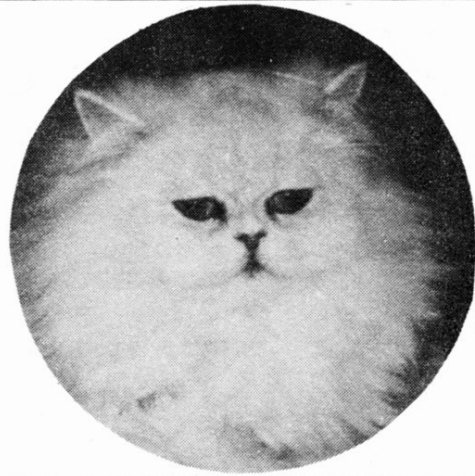

white cats involves the hypostasis of a single gene to the normal alternative at the white locus. Simply explained this suggests that the gene concerned can be present in the genotype of both white and coloured cats but that its effect is suppressed in the latter. This hypothesis would seem to explain the in-

eye of the siamese dilution or that of the blue eye resulting from interaction between white and siamese, but the inference is that both genes, i.e. siamese and the blue eye gene, can be inherited alongside each other.

The older hypothesis proposed that white interacts with white spotting and that certain white masked spotted phenotypes (where the masked colour does not surround the eyes or ears) produced the effects of blue eyes and deafness. On this hypothesis all blue eyed white other than white masked Siamese or deaf white cats of any eye colour would at least have to be heterozygous for white spotting but data collected from British breeders has since proved this is not always the case. However, the phenomena serve as good examples of the way in which genes can work together.

Some genes are known as polygenes and although further consideration will be given to polygenic or quantitative inheritance later, it can be explained that they are additive in effect building up an expression by minute degrees. Sex linked and sex limited genes have already been simply described and they, too, will be discussed more fully at a later date.###

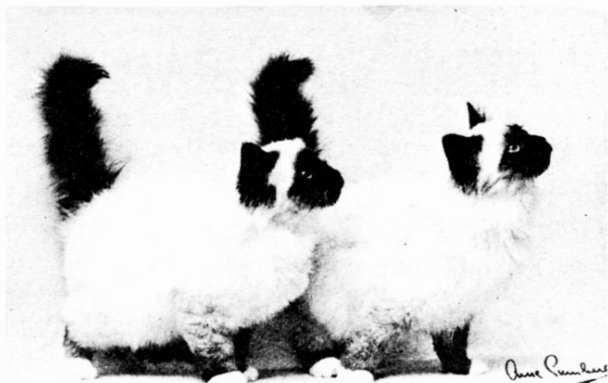

lenge. There are calories and fluids to keep up with in a cat that refuses everything. It is an hourly process of giving water, beef broth, chicken broth by dropper until the cat will accept food from your fingertip. What a great relief it is when the cat voluntarily takes its first bite of food!

The sick cat takes all of your ingenuity in feeding. Stimulate its appetite by giving one of the pediatric vitamin drops such as Vitamino. If your veterinarian approves, try some Vita Treat. This is a cattle vitamin supplement which contains a broad spectrum antibiotic. Since the amount required is so extremely small, it is easy to get into the food mixture of the sick cat.

This two-part review of nutrition in cats has been all-too-brief because there has been little interest in researching the problem. You can help remedy this by making a contribution to the Robert H. Winn Foundation for Feline Research, P.O. Box 430, Red Bank, NJ 07701.###

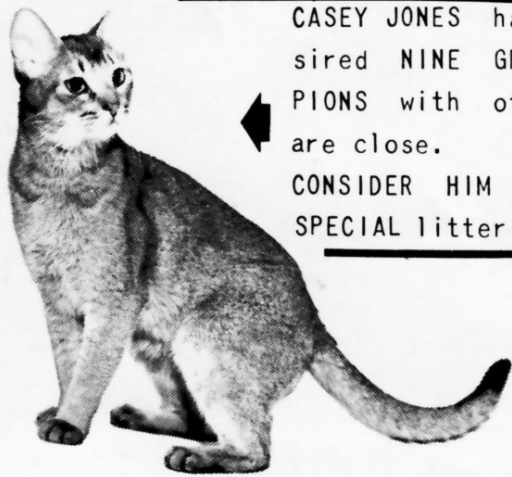

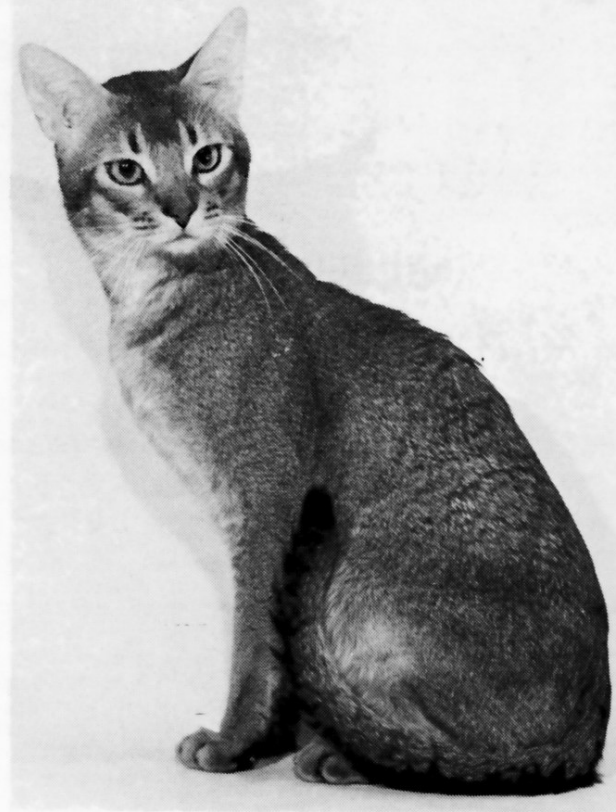
