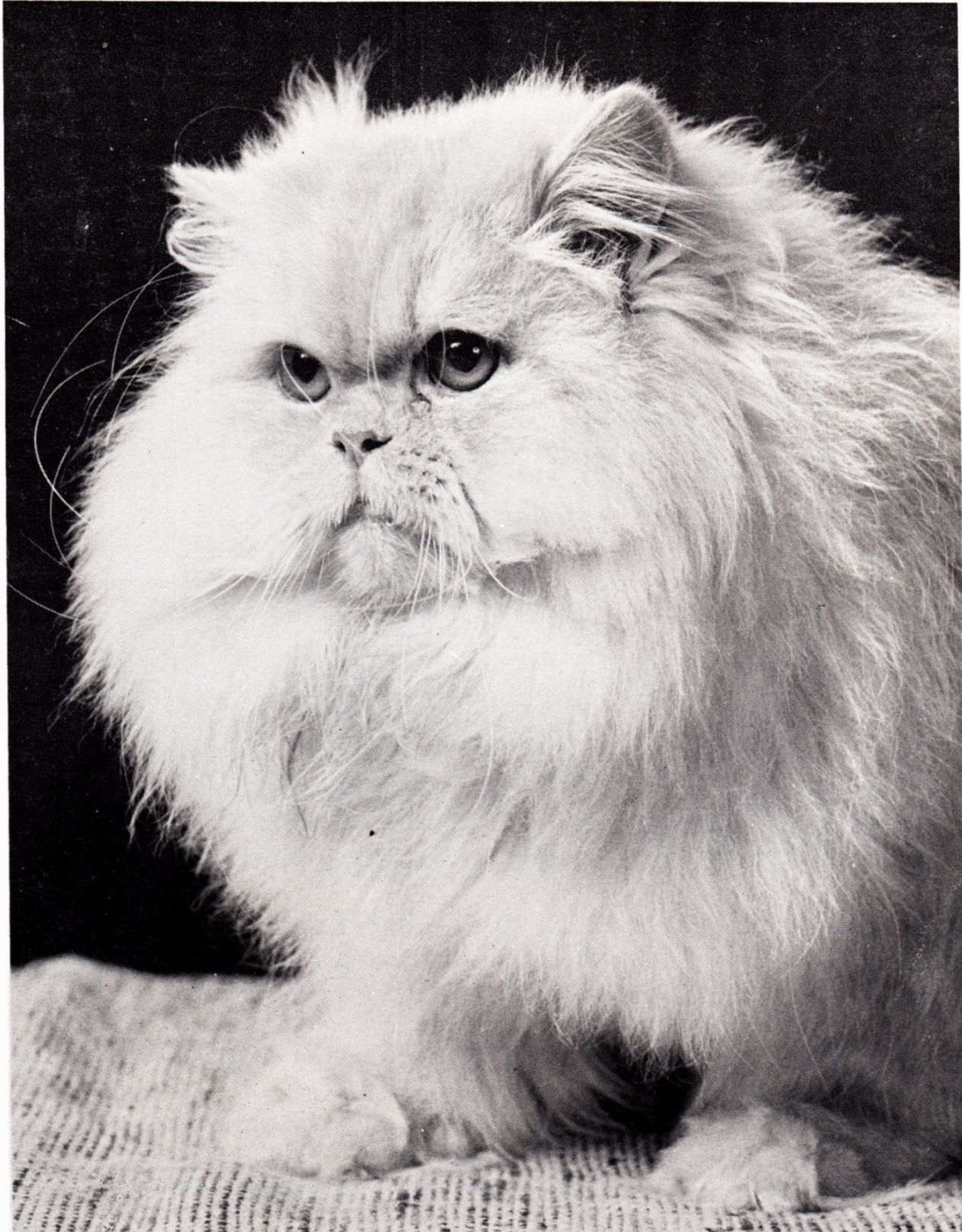

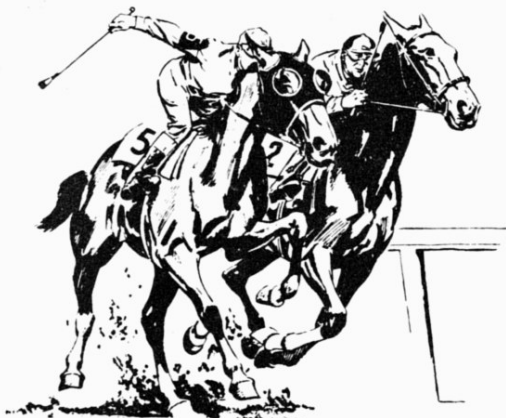

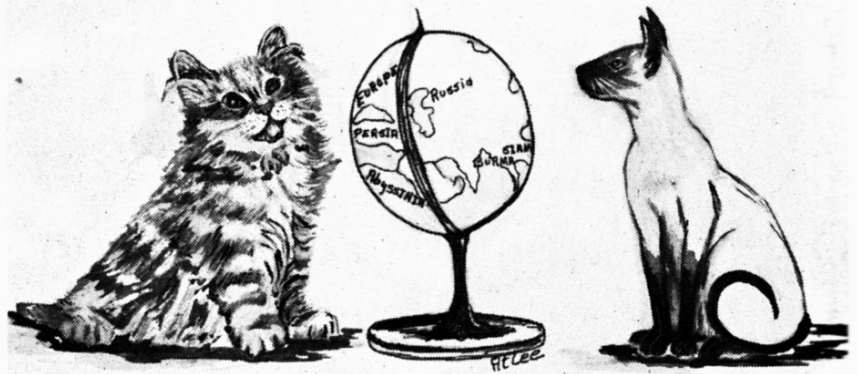
COVER CAT

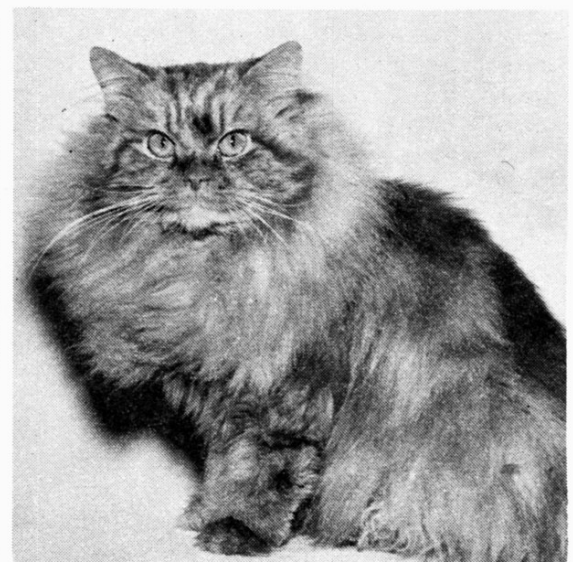
THOSE LOVABLE RED TABBIES

My fascination with Red Tabby Persians began 40 years ago when my first entry at the Ohio State Fair was disqualified because his tail was too long. This lovely boy, *GENERAL PERSHING*, later lost the tip of his tail in an accident, thus leaving it the desired length, and I then realized that I wanted to do something to improve the quality of the Red Tabbies. A number of years were to pass, however, before "Smithway", my cattery, could begin the extensive breeding program for the development of these beautiful cats.

About 1930 the interest in Red Tabbies was greatly accelerated in America by the import of the phenomenal Red Tabby male, *EASTBURY TRIGO*, bred by Mrs. Fosbury of England. He was the first cat to win a CFA Grand Championship and the first Red Tabby to consistently win "Best Cat in Show" over the outstanding Blues in this country. Before he was retired in 1933, four years before his death, he had been "Best Cat in Show" (All Breed) nine times, as well as twelve times "Best Kitten" in England. He was never defeated for "Best of Color" at anytime. It is said that he never sired a kitten quite as good as himself, perhaps due to the lack of females of similar quality. However, he did leave two sons, bred by Mr. Arch Horn, who became very well known. The litter brothers were *GR. CH. KOPPER KETTLE KRUSADER OF ROCKRIDGE*, owned by Julie M. Hunter, Mt. Vernon, New York, and *CH. KOPPER KETTLE KOURDELEON*, owned by Dr. and Mrs. H.K. Miller, Columbus, Ohio. I was fortunate enough to obtain my first "top quality" female kitten from the Millers and she produced a son who, in many ways, resembled his great grandsire, the memorable *TRIGO*.

The first issue of the "CFA Year Book", 1958, printed the following tribute from "Cats' Magazine", October, 1949, in memory of *EASTBURY TRIGO*, thirteen years after his death: "*Import Eastbury Trigo is generally conceded to be the greatest Red Tabby of all time. This cat was bred in England and is regarded by the English cat fancy as the finest red tabby ever bred there and perhaps the most outstanding feline in the show ring, and the general consensus of opinion is that he was the finest red tabby to compete in America.*" What a heritage to leave for posterity!

The years passed and, as the Red Tabby became more popular in the 1930's, many American breeders continued to work with them. After World War II, this color seemed to lose popularity with breeders. Representation was small or non-existent in the shows. A few breeders did "carry on", including Mrs. Robert Treat, Calavoron Cattery, Middleburg, Connecticut; and Mrs. Ella Conroy, Elco Cattery, New Richmond, Ohio. Today, one finds many cats carrying the Elco bloodline.

Red Tabbies have always been most popular in the Midwest and least popular on the West Coast. When I arrived in California in 1947, I was amazed to find only one or two

entries in the shows, and it was a time of great excitement if a Red Tabby won a "Best of Color" ribbon. After searching for a while, I finally found a Red Tabby queen which I felt was of similar quality to the Red Tabbies in the Midwest. I purchased this kitty from Mrs. Florence Parry, Diablo Cattery, Los Angeles. To this day, I have never seen the equal of the rich, mahogany coloring on this cat, QUAD CH. BELMONT BOBETTE OF SMITHWAY. Times have changed, type has changed, but the color and contrast still remain a "thing of beauty" for the Red Tabbies.

A CHALLENGE TO BREED

It is a real challenge to breed Red Tabbies for they must meet the standard of perfection of the solid Persian colors. Today's tabby is a far cry from the long-nosed, big-eared, foxy-faced cat of yesteryear. Long bodies and long legs are "out", while the short, cobby, well-balanced body is desired. The tabby must also have the wide width of skull, round face, and short, thick neck found in other Persian colors. To this are added the definite requirements for the *RED TABBY* and the *PEKE FACE RED TABBY* Persians. The Red Tabbies are divided into these two separate types, and they are two extremely different types of Red Tabbies.

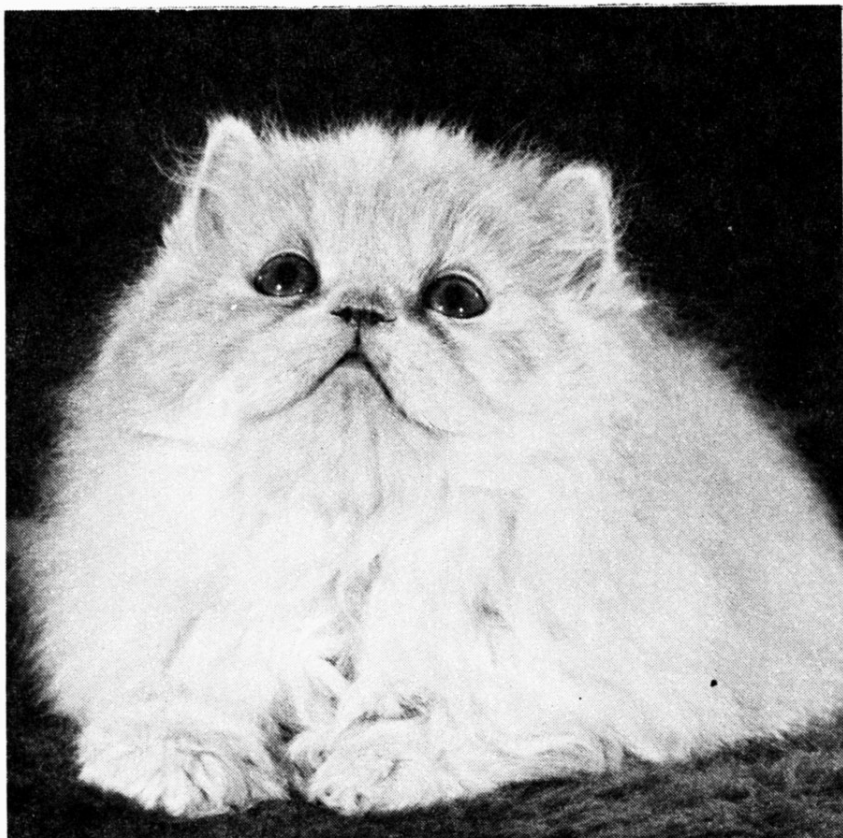

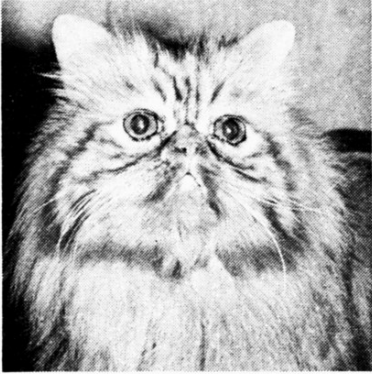
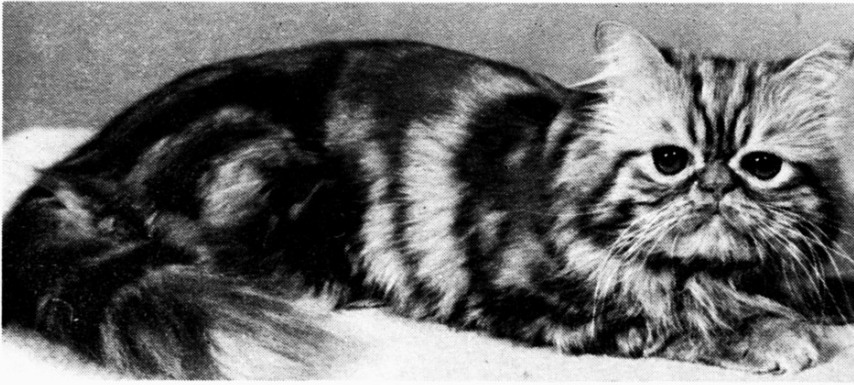
TRU-LUV'S CALIFORNIA BONANZA, 3½ weeks

setter dog. The markings are deep mahogany and form a decided contrast to the ground color. The pattern of markings, whether classic or mackerel, should provide a dazzling appearance when contrasted with the basic ground color. *TABBY* comes from the French *TABIS*, meaning watermarked - as moire taffeta. It is easy to see how this is comparable to the markings on the tabby cat. Tabby markings are a dominant trait and can also be found on some solid color kittens at birth, such as the Blue Persians. These soon fade in a few weeks, but a true tabby has tabby markings which are "tabby" to the skin. They are not surface markings which fade with age, as found on many so-called tabbies that have been crossed with solid colors. Each hair is the same color from tip to root. The large, deep copper, almost red eyes, seem to match the darker pattern of the red tabby cat.

The Red Tabby is divided into classes according to pattern of markings. The Mackerel Tabby pattern refers to dense, narrow penciled markings which remind one of the mackerel fish. These lines must be clearly defined and meet the pattern standard for Mackerel Tabbies. These cats are becoming more popular with selective breeding, and one now finds them occasionally in the shows.

The Classic Red Tabby is indeed a "thing of beauty". The markings must be dense and clear, from the "M" on the forehead to the rings on the tail. The "butterfly", which forms wings across the shoulders, meets the spinal markings down the back. These three vertical stripes seem to be the hardest part of the pattern to retain. The side markings of swirls, or circles, must be the same on both sides. Our Red Tabby would not be well-dressed without the necklaces around his neck and the bracelets on his legs - better known as "bars". To really be complete, he should

have a vertical row of buttons on his chest and stomach and a "dot" or button on his shoulder. These would be the ultimate in a classic tabby --- and the hardest parts of breeding the perfect Red Tabby.

What is known as the "Standard" Red Tabby Persian refers to a Persian with a "break" in his nose, although it is not extreme. He follows the standards set by the associations

THE POPULAR PEKE-FACE

Then there is the Peke Face Red Tabby, the real "problem child" of the tabbies, and one of the most popular and best loved of all tabbies. The Peke Face cat must conform in color, markings and general type to the Red Tabby Persian but there is a great difference in the head and skull of the Peke Face cat. He just does not conform to this standard. The head somewhat resembles that of the Pekinese dog, from which it gets its name. The ears are larger and higher placed. They would look strange if they were placed low on the sides of the head. The nose of the Peke Face cat is very short and depressed, and there is an indentation between the eyes. There must be a second indentation in the skull above the eyes. The muzzle is wrinkled, and the eyes are large and very prominent, with the lower lid drooping somewhat. This characteristic is peculiar to Peke cats. Their bone structure is not as massive as other Persians, the cat as a whole being smaller and daintier. The toe nails are hooked and very sharp, and many Pekes have beautifully curled whiskers which add a beguiling appearance to the face. Pekes also enjoy feeding themselves with their paws. Their personalities are outstanding; they are lovers from the word "go". They crave affection and demand attention. They love to be petted and will caress you as long as you will let them.

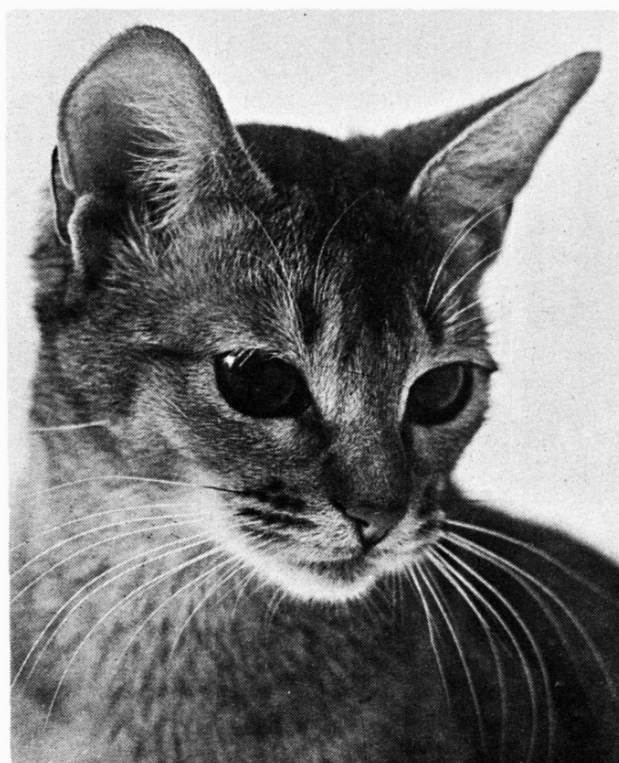
Peke Face cats do have problems which differ from those of other tabbies. Their eyes "weep" and must constantly be cleansed. If afflicted with a respiratory infection, that short nose makes it difficult for them to breathe - and one must run for the inhalator. Many Peke Face queens have their kittens born by Caesarian section, and there is a higher rate of mortality of newborn kittens than with other Persians. The kittens themselves are slow to mature and remain kittens for a longer period than the standard Red Tabby. The females make good mothers and train their kittens well. They are the cleanest cats in the world.

Breeding the Peke Faces themselves is also a problem. One cannot breed two Peke Face parents and expect to get all Peke Face kittens as the gene is recessive. One might get all standards, while two standard parents carrying the Peke gene could produce some lovely Peke Face kittens. There would also be some standard kittens in the litter. At Smithway, we seem to produce the best Peke kittens when the sire is a Peke Face and the dam is a good standard.

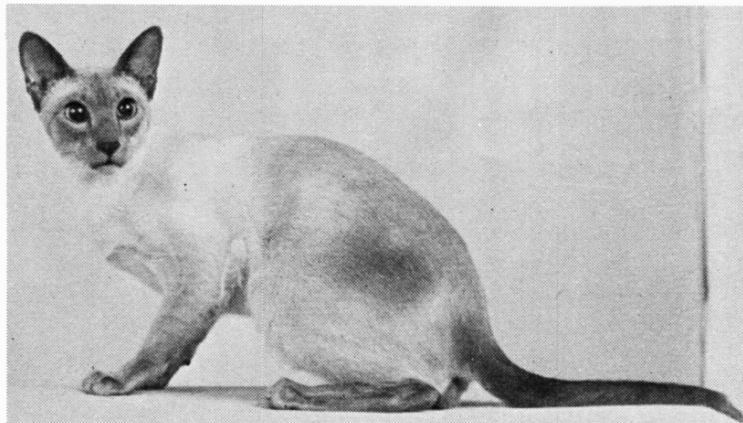

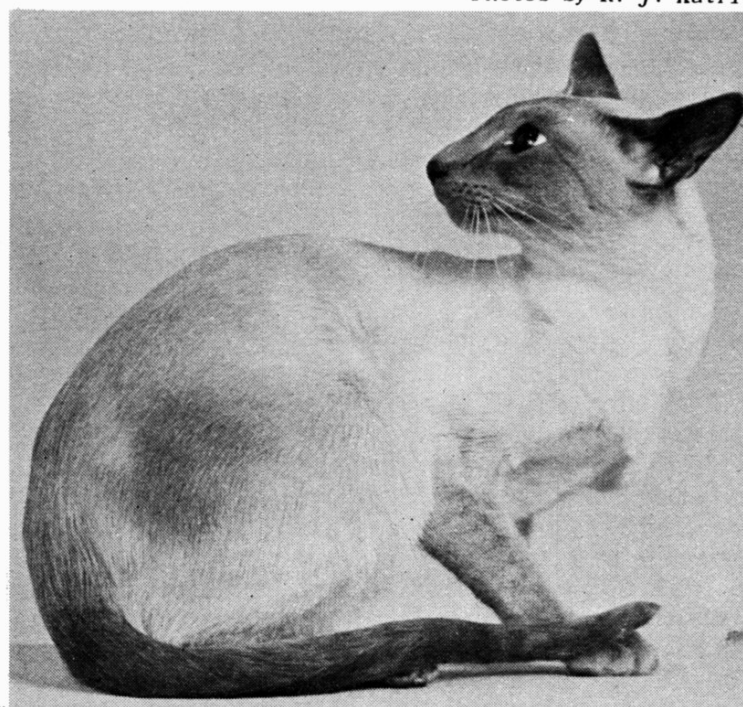

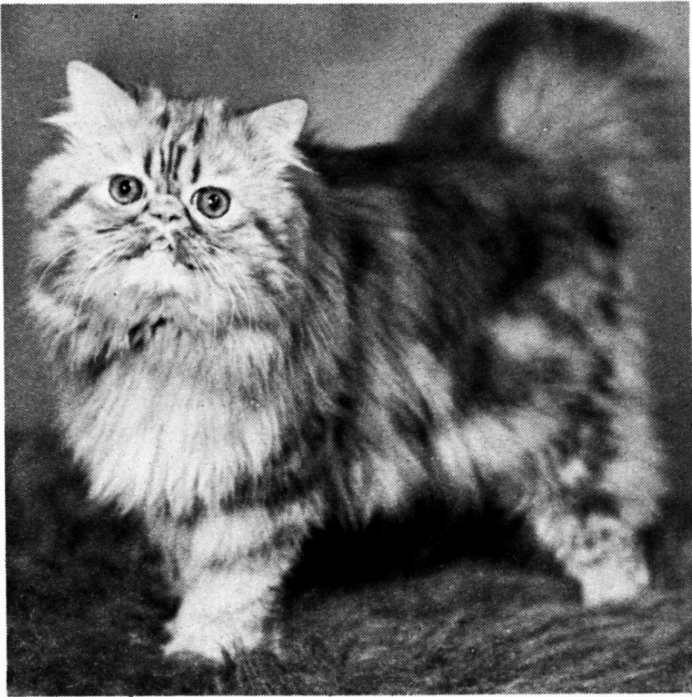

BREEDING HINTS

It is important when breeding Red Tabbies not to cross too many bloodlines. This will result in "broken pattern" lines going in every direction, being neither classic or mackerel tabby. We do breed tabby to tabby, using good line breeding, for three generations. It is important that the male have excellent type, as we find he passes it on to his offspring. Color and markings seem to be passed by either or both parents.

We have found that the best breeding to improve type in Red Tabbies is to breed to a very typey Tortoiseshell. The resulting kittens from this female will have a rather muddy color and faint markings. However, a male kitten from this latter bred back to a female Red Tabby of the original line will regain the lost color and contrast. We prefer breeding to the Tortoiseshell rather than to a Black or Blue as we are one generation ahead since the Tortie is already carrying these colors. We will have obtained the better head type and stocky body which are needed to improve the Red Tabbies.

It seems to be true that one can't have everything in a Red Tabby. If a breeder gets lovely type, he may lose the deep color and good contrast. The cat with gorgeous mahogany color and brilliant markings has a long nose and huge ears. With judicious, selective breeding, breeders are trying to overcome this factor, and consider that they are accomplishing it. Many Red Tabby kittens are both typey and have deep color.

Red Tabby kittens, both standard and peke face types, have certain characteristics at birth which carry through to adulthood. The red tabby pattern of color markings at birth does not change when the cat is an adult. As a kitten's pattern is at birth, so will it be when grown. At about four weeks, with the growth of the fluffy kitten coat, the markings disappear and will not appear

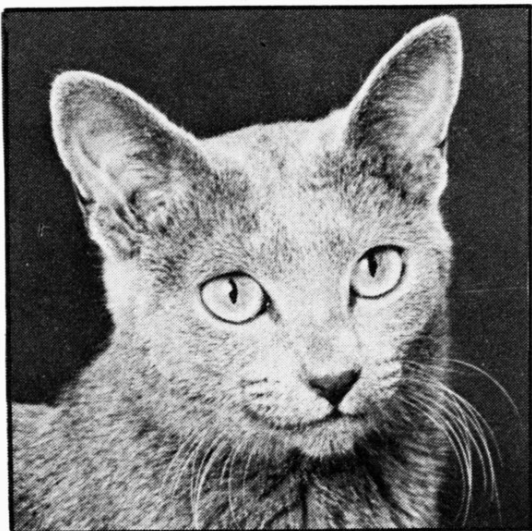
again until the kitten is two to three months old. A kitten's coat color may lighten or darken with age, but usually the coat becomes darker with maturity. Bone structure shows at birth, specially in facial features. A Peke kitten has larger eye slits with larger eye sockets than the standard. The small indentation in the skull above the eyes can be felt in a newborn Peke kitten. Peke Face kittens usually have larger ears than the standard Red Tabby kittens.

Kittens that seem "extremely peke" at birth may over-develop malformations of the jaw when adult. The tongue may protrude and the "fangs", or canines, may show on the outside of the mouth. There may be a slight deformity of the jaw (more narrow) with a lesser number of small teeth between the fangs. There may be four instead of six small teeth, both above and below. This is not evident until the permanent teeth are cut and does not necessarily disqualify the kitten for show. Many cats have four instead of six incisors between the canines.

I have found no difference in the body type between a standard and a Peke type Red Tabby kitten at birth. Both may or may not have a long tail, long legs and large ears. The Peke Face kitten may be a little smaller in size, but not always. He just seems to develop a little slower. A white locket or a white tip on the tail of a red tabby kitten is a disqualification factor. If the kitten has it at birth, he will have it with his adult coat. Here one must consider the crossing of bloodlines to bring out only the best characteristics of known ancestry.

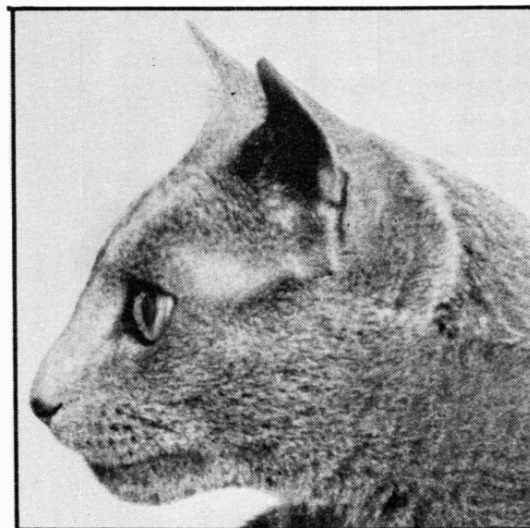
GROOMING

Grooming of the Red Tabby Persian is easier than of the Solids or Silvers. The hair combs easily and does not mat as quickly. The hair itself is different from other Persian coats. It is not quite as long and has a thick, plushy appearance somewhat like velvet. In grooming, the hair is combed down to show the markings to better advantage. If the coat were long and fluffy, the markings would not be visible. When preparing a Red Tabby for show, he must first be bathed in a mild protein shampoo, then thoroughly rinsed (we use a rinse with body) until his hair fairly "crackles", so that there is no skum left to dull the natural luster of his coat. Most Red Tabbies seem to have curly hair on their stomachs. We have found that a beige-colored powder brushed on that section after the cat is dried from his bath will help to separate the hair. This is all brushed out on the night before the show. Nothing is needed for the back and sides of the cat except a good brushing and combing with a fine-toothed comb. About a half hour before the cat is judged, we very lightly use a grooming spray on the back of the cat and comb the markings in. A little Listerine spread on with the hand will work just as well. When showing a Red Tabby, one must always make sure the eyes and nose

Breeder's Notebook

by A. DAVID BANDY

3. Coat Color

We are having a beautiful Spring here in California. I have been out in the yard planting fuchsias. We still need a lot more rain, but everyone seems to be getting along with what we have.

There has been correspondence from several countries and I want to thank everyone for being patient. I shall attempt to answer as many inquiries as possible and ask readers to remember that these replies are merely my opinions and not gospel material!

COAT COLOR

When cat breeders refer to the subject of genetics, they frequently have in mind the mechanism of coat color inheritance. There are factors which make this mechanism in cats unique.

All coat color genes in cats are found on the female sex chromosome, except for the gene for white coat color which is found on a regular (autosomal) chromosome. All normal female cats have two female sex chromosomes (XX). All normal male cats have one female sex chromosome and one male sex chromosome (XY). By examination, we can now say that all female cats carry at least two genes for coat color while all male cats carry at least one gene for coat color. Furthermore, we can also state that a male cat only passes his male chromosome to his sons to make them males so, in the case of these sex-linked coat color genes, a male cat does not pass a coat color gene to his sons, they must obtain it from their mothers.

There are three basic coat colors in cats but modification from other genetic influences produce the vast variety we see in present day domestic felines. The three basic colors are: Red and Black which are of equal dominance (if both are present in an animal they both will show in the coat, i.e. Tortoiseshells and Bluecreams), and White which is the dominant color in cats. A White cat carries other genes for coat color, the sex-linked genes, but if a cat carries a gene for white coat color it will show in its coat. Put another way: one parent at least must be White to produce White kittens in a litter.

There is a dilution gene that changes Red to Cream and Black to Blue if a pair of them are present in the cat. If a cat only has one dilution gene, it will still be either Red or Black or both but two cats with one dilution gene each can be mated and pro-

duce dilutes (Blues, Creams, Bluecreams) in the litter. Conversely, there can be Blacks, Reds, Torties without any dilution genes that will produce only the non-dilute colors (Reds, Blacks and Torties) irregardless of what they are bred to. Also there can be Whites that carry two genes for White coat color that will never have anything but white kittens because they pass a White coat color gene to all their offspring.

The pattern genes modify the basic colors to produce some interesting results. Silvers, Brown Tabbies and Silver Tabbies are basically Black cats; Cameos and Red Tabbies are basically Red cats.

It is possible to predict the possibilities of coat color in a litter. On the chart below, combine the coat colors of the parents and where they intersect you will find your results. Bear in mind that White coat color is the wild card and is inherited from either parent.

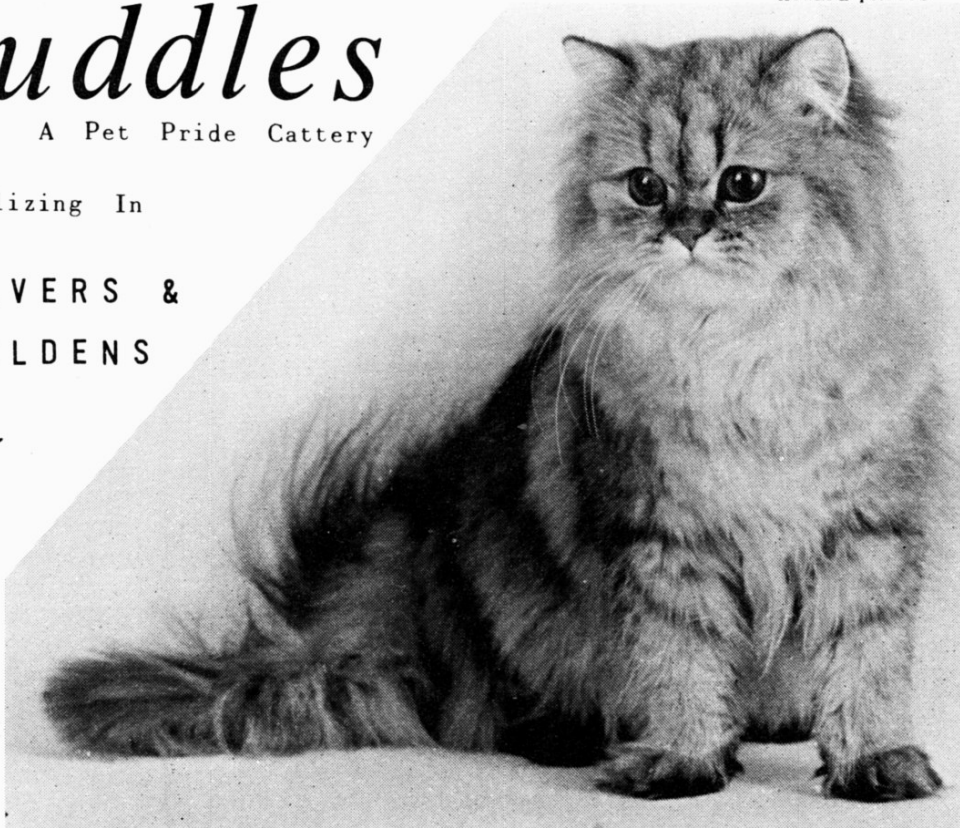

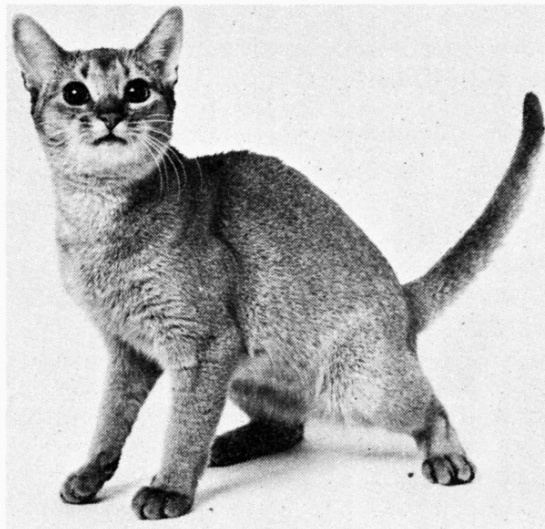

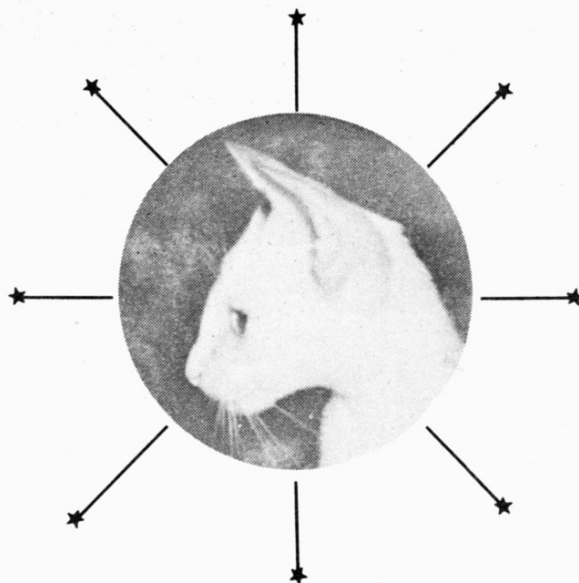

Dear Mr. Vrana:

It appears to me that Golden Persians are basically Brown Tabby Persians that are obtained from Silver Persian stock. I find it a simplification to consider all Persians to be evolved from a tabby ancestor. Then we, as breeders, select the type of coat pattern and color we wish in our breeding program. Since I have bred all the basic colors of Persians, and have crossed many of these colors and patterns for one purpose or another, I have seen some interesting results on occasion. I have obtained Brown Tabbies (Goldens) from crosses of Silvers with solid colors. I have done this basically to improve the type in my Silver stock. In the U.S.A., all Persians have the same conformation standards with the variation being on coat color, coat pattern and eye color. All Persians should have copper eye color except for Silvers and Silver Tabbies which should have green eye color.

It is possible to standardize the coat pattern by selecting the pattern desired and using it in your breeding program. Originally solid colors evolved from tabby stock through selection. It is also possible to evolve tabbies from solid colors through selection. However, with outstanding specimens of either used in your programs, it speeds up the process considerably.

If you have outstanding specimens of a breed to use, then by breeding solid to solid, shaded to shaded, or tabby to tabby, you generally insure that your offspring will be of the pattern of the parents. It may require several generations of selective breeding where you are using only the color of cat desired in your breedings before you can obtain litters without any other color than the parents.

I find in crossing my silvers with my solid colors that Brown Tabbies are more likely to occur in the litters where there is solid color ancestry in the more recent pedigree. Therefore, it would be possible to produce a line of Goldens eventually just as lines of Silvers have been produced. Unfortunately, as in all animal breeding programs, the time and effort are so great that it eliminates all but a few from any programs that span more than a few years.

The differences between the Golden and the Brown Tabby is the coat pattern and the eye color. Green eye color seems to be the basic eye color of the non-pedigreed cat so it should not be so hard to regain. I hold type to be of the most importance so I would be inclined to establish outstanding Persian type in my stock and then begin concentrating on proper color and eye color while still maintaining the outstanding type in my stock. If I would lose my type, I would immediately attempt to regain it before proceeding on in my breeding program. You may have a cat with the most beautiful coat, color and body - but if the cat doesn't have outstanding type he is most generally overlooked in the competition.

I need some help concerning a female of mine that fails to conceive. She goes into a regular season at 5 to 6 weeks apart (she is 1½ years old) and has only had 4 seasons. She goes into a very hard season, breeds readily and appears to be pregnant, then reverses and suddenly is not pregnant.

Dear Mrs. Varn:

To keep matters simple, I shall use the tacit of what I would do with such a female in my operation and let the reader accept or reject the information as it pleases him.

We can learn a great deal from Mother Nature if we will just observe her in an inquisitive manner. When we maintain animals in captivity, we often do things to them unknowingly to their detriment. Thankfully most of them survive and even reproduce on what we modify for them but there are occasionally those few that present problems. It might be well here to state that it requires a much more balanced level of nutrition to encourage animals to reproduce than to merely maintain them.

I would first approach the problem from a nutritional aspect. I would make certain that the cat had an adequate amount of raw bone in her diet. The best possible nutrition in my estimation would be a whole raw animal (mice, baby chicks, etc.), but permit the carnivore to have the entire, uncleaned animal and to do with it as she sees fit. (If you prefer, you can grind this up with the cat's regular food but be sure to include every part.) If given the proper nutritional ingredients, an animal can balance its diet and adjust its metabolic patterns itself far better than you can. After several weeks of such a diet, I would then begin to breed the cat as she came into season. Be patient as it may require some time.

I once had a Black Smoke Persian that had been bred for three years without success. I then permitted her to live in the barn with the farm cats and learn how to hunt like they did and catch her own food. Within six months she was pregnant by a barn cat, eventually delivering four kittens. I then bred her to a Persian male and she produced normally.

I would only use hormones as a last resort. There are so many fluctuations in the various hormone levels in the body that to bombard the system with a hormone injection, in my estimation, should be carefully considered.

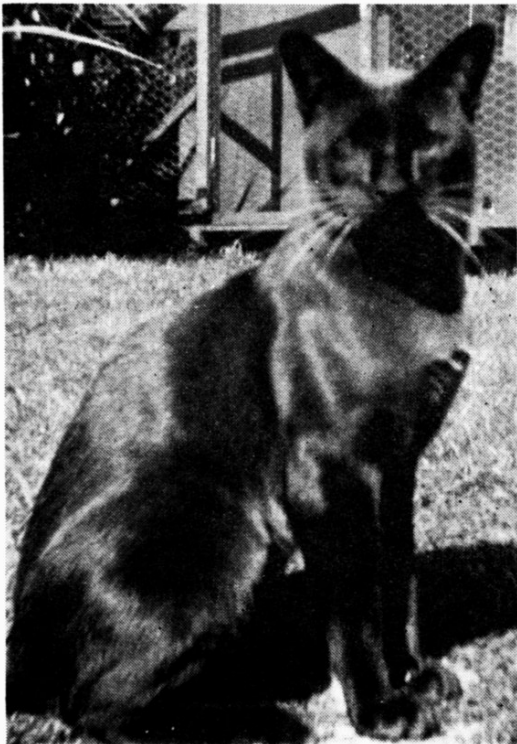
NEW ZEALAND, 1976

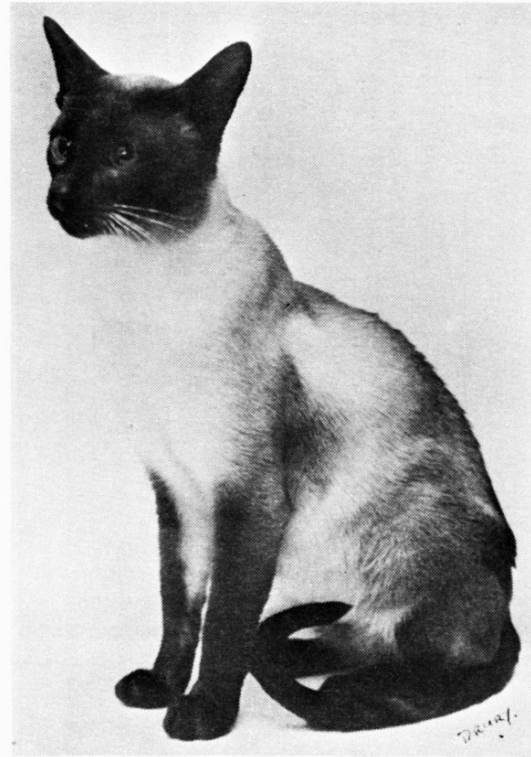
In 1976, for the first time in the history of the cat fancy in our country, New Zealand cats have been scored throughout the show season for annual awards. The *CAT WORLD* Awards scheme is free of charge to clubs and exhibitors and our beautiful N.Z. winners are presented here gaining them the international recognition they so richly deserve. Many proud owners and breeders have honoured their winners with photos, etc., for fanciers all over the world to see.

This exciting new programme adds an incentive to all N.Z. exhibitors as previously cats' show careers reached their ultimate upon achieving Grand Champion status - no higher award being available. Now the goal is to feature in N.Z.C.W.'s Best Cats annually and we sincerely thank *CAT WORLD Magazine* for this generous opportunity to participate.

Every cat entered in a 1976 show was scored automatically for Open Class, Best of Breed, Best In Show, Runner-Up to Best In Show and Opposite Sex Best In Show placings. This was a mammoth task made very difficult for our Honorary Scorer, New Zealand Cat Fancy Honours Officer, Mrs. Emily Pattison, by many Clubs sending insufficiently marked catalogues. However, with all Clubs participating fully now, and an expanded scoring system for 1977, we do not envisage any further

problems like this. Emily Pattison deserves tremendous appreciation for the dedicated and excellent way she handled this difficult job all season.

The New Zealand Cat Fancy has 33 registered Clubs (23 All Breeds and 10 Non-All Breeds Clubs) and most run a Championship show once a year with some of the larger ones running two for a total of 35. Of the 33 Championship shows, 23 are held in the North Island and only ten in the South Island which means a considerable amount of travelling for South Islanders wishing to exhibit more.

The Felix National Cat Show, sponsored by J. Watties Canneries Ltd., is our largest but some other All Breeds Shows are also heading towards the 1000 entry mark. The majority of shows have around 200 to 700 entries while the Non-All Breeds have about 150 to 400. The 1976 N.Z. Siamese Show had 221 Siamese entered which is tremendous for a show restricted to Siamese only. Southern Cross L/H Cat Club had 193 exhibits at their first show held in 1976, a great effort for a new club. The Felix National is held annually in different regions; Canterbury All Breed Cat Club ran the 1976 show in Christchurch with an entry of approximately 1,100 cats. A special feature of the National is that judges are brought for it all the way from America, England or Australia.

NEW GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GRAND PREMIERS

There were nine new Grands in 1975 (6 S/H, 3 L/H) but 1977 may see a slight increase due to amalgamation of champion classes resulting in the Grand Challenge not having to be withheld so many times when insufficient entries are present which has been so disappointing to exhibitors in the past.

SCORING OF THE CURRENT SEASON

The 1977 show season began in New Zealand in March. Improvements can always be made in any system and scoring for the 1977 New Zealand and CAT WORLD Awards will follow a new pattern. Hurle and Rae Rayner, our N.Z.C.F. Honours Officers and NZCW Honorary Scorers, are already busy scoring 1977 show winners. All N.Z.C.F. registered clubs must send fully marked catalogues to them for Fancy records and these are being used for 1977 scoring as well. Clubs are now offering from five upwards BIS placings, e.g. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th Best In Show, etc., and naturally exhibitors are choosing shows giving the highest number of placings, thereby the most opportunities to gain points for CW scoring. Clubs do not have to provide prizes for these placings, although many are.

One point will be scored for every cat present and competing, less one. Therefore, 10th BIS placing out of 100 exhibits gains 90 points, instead of perhaps BOB out of 20 exhibits gaining just 19 points. This adds tremendous interest as otherwise BIS and RU BIS would score a large number of points and 3rd BIS cat, with little competition at BOB level would only gain 2 or 3 points.

All exhibits receive points for their highest placing in the show only, i.e. exhibits placed in the BIS placings automatically drop any points accumulated at lower levels. Cats not featuring in the Top BIS placings will receive points for Group wins (All Solid Col. L/H, all Broken Col. L/H) and cats not featuring in Group wins will receive points for Breed wins, by the same method of one point for every cat present and competing less one. This method of scoring allows winners at big shows to accrue more points than winners at small shows, i.e. points allotted on the number of cats beaten.

As these Awards are for the Best cats and not just the most exhibited cats, all national awards will be allocated on the highest average points, i.e. all points for the season divided by the number of times the cat is exhibited. Dividing the total points by the number of times shown protects our cats from being overshadowed and also does not penalise exhibitors who cannot afford the time or money to travel to many shows. Any scoring system has its anomalies, but it is hoped that the new system for 1977 will allow participation by many more exhibitors. Many complicated scoring methods have been considered but the merit in this system is its simplicity and fairness.###

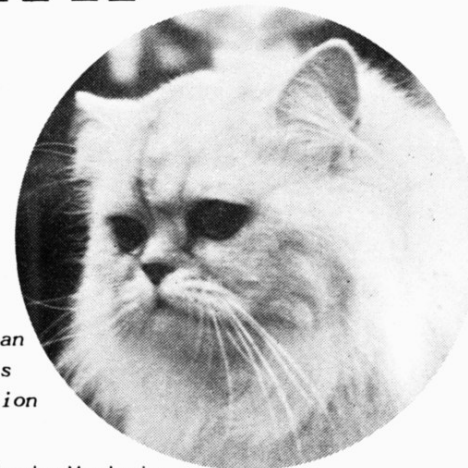

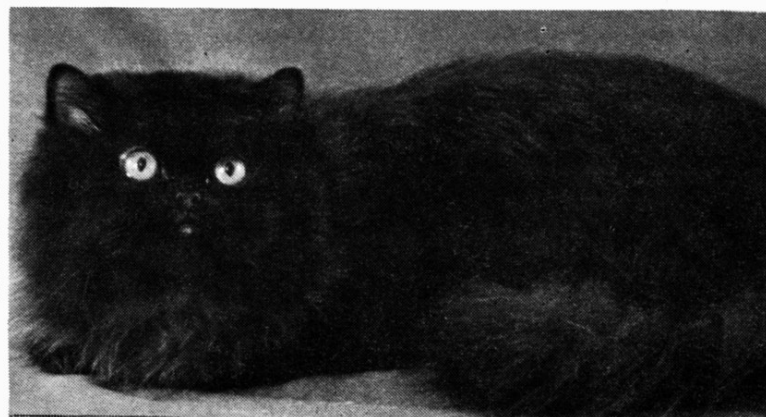

AN INTRODUCTION TO THE CFA JUDGING PROGRAM

Part 3

TRAINEE SECOND CLASS

In this series to date, we have considered how to evaluate your readiness to make application to enter the CFA Judging Program, how to apply, the processing of your request, and the initial steps in your training program. Your performance as Chief Clerk proved satisfactory and you have now been advanced to your next assignment: Trainee Second Class. This involves the judging of color classes under the supervision of an approved judge.

What is a "color class"? It is actually a group of classes for one color of one particular breed, i.e. Seal Point Siamese Novices, Opens, Champions and Grand Champions, both males and females.

As a Trainee, you must secure permission in writing signed by the show manager of the club at whose show you will do any type of color class and send this to the Judging Program Chairman, Mrs. Swenson, together with the names of the officiating judges for that show. Mrs. Swenson will select one of these judges as your supervisor for that show and will prepare the necessary report form to be submitted to that judge for completion about your work. You will not be permitted to enter any cats in any of the rings at the show.

On the opening day of the show, you will

report to the officiating judge under whom you are to work prior to the start of judging and will remain with this judge until completion of all judging in that ring and your dismissal by the judge.

You will not have access to a show catalog until your dismissal but, when it has been determined by the Judging Program Chairman and the officiating judge what color classes you are to handle, you will make for yourself duplicate Judge's Slips for your awards, copying the information from the official Judge's Book.

In order to save time, as well as undue handling of the exhibits, you, as Trainee, will take each cat in turn in the class you are to judge from its judging cage and place it on the table. The officiating judge will make his examination of the cat while you stand back and observe his handling and technique. When the judge has finished, you will examine the entry and then return it to its judging cage. Before the officiating judge hangs the ribbons for the cats of his choice, you will mark your judging slip for each cat you have handled giving 1st, 2nd, 3rd, winners, best of color and 2nd best of color. You will make your decisions without consulting your supervisor as to their wisdom or validity, judging each entry by the CFA standard for the breed and color. Your choices will have no official bearing on the awards made by the officiating judge who will then hang the ribbons according to his own decisions.

At this point, before the cats are dismissed from the ring, you will confer privately with the judge to compare awards and briefly discuss any major differences.

TRAINEE FIRST CLASS

When you have judged satisfactorily a sufficient number of color classes as a Trainee Second Class to be deemed by the Judging Program Chairman ready for more advanced work, you will be assigned to judge color classes in the capacity of Trainee First Class. The officiating judge, under whose tutelage you are working, will observe your actions from a point outside the ring.

You will be assigned to judge one or more color classes at a show as decided upon by the Judging Program Chairman and the officiating judge. However, in contrast to the normal procedure in a ring, you will have no indication of the status of each entry. Your class of Seal Point Siamese could be comprised of novices, opens, champions, or grands---most likely they will be a combination of all grades. You will be called upon to examine the exhibits and award 1st, 2nd, 3rd and winners---just as though you were judging a class of novices or opens---in the male portion of the class, and then make similar awards to the females. You will then be required to award 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings as though the males and females present were all entered in one big class regardless of sex.

You will note your awards and comments on a Judge's Book slip and you will hang ribbons in accordance with your decisions. Such awards will have no official status and, after the cats have been judged in the normal manner by the officiating judge, you will collect the ribbons you have hung on the cages; they will not be taken by the exhibitors. The officiating judge will hang the official ribbons to mark his own decisions.

Again, following judging of the entries by both you and the officiating judge, a short private discussion will help you see why the judge did not agree with one or more of your decisions (if that be the case). It is expected that there will be some differences in the decisions of you and the officiating judge. Where there are wide variations you will be asked to give logical reasons for your decisions and may be expected to judge additional classes in the breed or color.

In the case of both a Trainee Second Class and a Trainee First Class, the officiating judge will complete and sign a confidential report form to be mailed directly to the Judging Program Chairman. In this report, the judge will make comments on the tangible and intangible aspects of the Trainee's qualifications for judging and will answer specific questions on the form. The judge will also offer suggestions which might be helpful to the Trainee's future and aid the Chairman in making a realistic evaluation of the progress of the Trainee. It is important that the Chairman and the CFA Executive Board be completely informed in order that the latter can make its decision upon the advancement or otherwise of the Trainee in the Judging Program.

CFA CLUBS AND THE TRAINEE

As a Trainee, you may be invited by any CFA club to judge a Household Pet show but you will not be permitted to do any of the color class requirements of your training at any show at which you are going to judge HHPs. This also applies at a later date when you might be a judge in one category and a Trainee in another.

When you accept an invitation to judge Household Pets, the club will reimburse you for your expenses (travel, lodging, meals, tips and taxis), but you will not receive any fee for your judging services unless the show is a Stand Alone type HHP show.

As a Trainee, you may not involve yourself in any way in the discussion of possible invitations to judge, nor accept any invitations contingent on your possible promotion by the CFA Executive Board to the status of Apprentice Judge. The "Apprentice" stage of the CFA Judging Program will be discussed in Part 4 of this series.###

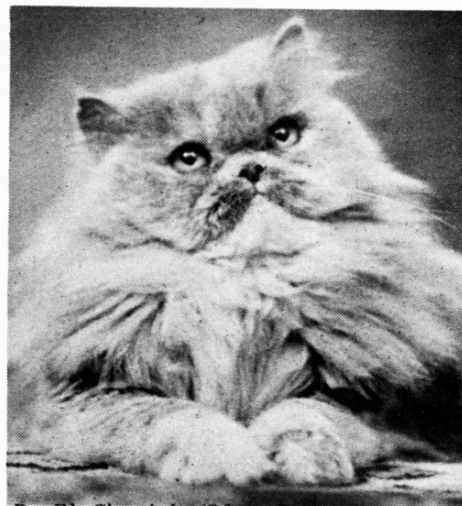

SOUTH AFRICA'S FIRST ABYSSINIAN GRAND

SAMBO OF YALA was born in Denmark on 7th April, 1971. Bred by Mrs. Henny Knudsen, his sire was *TOBIAS OF GLOMSDAL* and his dam *ZORBA AV NYBYNAS*. His four generation pedigree contains fourteen International Champions and two Champions so he has a formidable ancestry to live up to! And he certainly hasn't let them down.

This Ruddy Abyssinian male came to South Africa when he was seven months of age, arriving in the middle of our glorious summer. His birthplace, at this time, was mantled in heavy snow. His breeder wrote to me: "The day we sent *SAMBO* we had the worst weather we have had in Denmark for many, many years. At 3 o'clock all our traffic stopped at Odense, and it stopped at 6 o'clock in Copenhagen. *SAMBO* left by the last flight for several days." One might have expected our traveler to be affected by these dramatic climatic changes. Not so *SAMBO*. He arrived as happy as can be and that is exactly how he has been to this day. *SAMBO* is well-known in Cape Town cat circles for his fantastic temperament.

His rise to Grand Champion began on 4th March, 1972, when Mrs. Grace Haswell awarded him his first Challenge Certificate at the Rand Cat Club Championship Show in Johannesburg. He also received a rosette donated by the Platinum Coast Cat Club for Best Abyssinian. His second Challenge Certificate was awarded on 14th October, 1972, at the Western Province Cat Club show, Cape Town, by Mr. Don Daly. The third Certificate, making him Champion, was awarded by Mr. John Oliver at the Rand Cat Club Show that November.

With the limited number of opportunities to be shown in South Africa, and the fact that a Champion competes in a class with cats of other breeds, the road to the title Grand Champion can be very long. Although *SAMBO* frequently won the "Best Aby" award, he took a series of second and third awards in the Champions class. Then, on 6th October, 1973, Miss Gillian Burman awarded him his first Grand Challenge Certificate. It was a memorable day because he also won the Uppsala Katteklub Rosette for Best Cat In Show (Opposite Sex). Two years elapsed before he gained his second G.C.C. which was awarded to him by Miss Yvonne Akersten in Cape Town on 18th October, 1975. One more to win! His great day came on 3rd April, 1976, when, once again in the "Fair Cape", Miss Eileen Moore awarded the third and final Certificate and he became GRAND CHAMPION SAMBO OF YALA, the first Aby to win this title in the country!

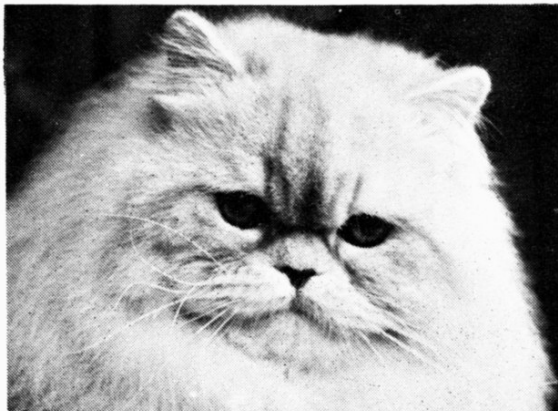
Amongst his progeny who are obtaining honours, his son, *CH. PLAYBOY OF SELWORTHY*, is quickly catching up to Dad, having to date been awarded two Grand Challenge Certificates. *SAMBO*'s "partner-in-crime", a Red Aby male imported from Dr. Jorgen Andersen of Denmark, *CH. KAI-LIN'S JUSTIN RUBER OF SIGIRIYA*, won his first Grand C.C. in March, 1977, so I am hoping soon to have a Red Grand Champion as well.###

International Cattery Tour

Mary Caito's Gay Purr-ee Cattery, Columbus, Ohio, is the fourth stop on our tour. Its residents are two stud cats, five queens and a spay - all Silver Persians. Mrs. Caito has been in the fancy for about fourteen years and shows her cats twice a month. Her description follows.

GAY PURR-EE cattery is located in what was once our recreation room. It measures 12 feet by 28 feet, has three windows, sound-proof ceiling and tiled floor. It is heated in winter and cooled in summer and has an exhaust fan.

The room is divided by a bar/counter which is used for grooming purposes. Below, it has built-in shelves for storage.

There are eight built-in cages constructed of tempered masonite with hardware cloth wire fronts and tiled floors. Each one is 40 inches x 40 inches x 60 inches long and contains a stool, litter box and a small vegetable bin which the cat uses as a bed.

On the north wall, which can be seen in the photo beyond the cages, there is a trophy shelf with storage space below. More storage space is provided beneath the cages.

In front of the counter, a frame hangs along the west wall for the display of rosettes; there is a window on either side. A similar frame faces it on the east wall where the louvered door can be seen. Along the south wall, not pictured, are climbing poles, shelves, etc.

The tiled floor area both in front of and behind the counter provides ample play area for the cats when out of the cages. They have lots of toys, beds and a community litter pan.

Cat pictures, photos and other items add an attractive decor to the cattery. The "Maternity Ward" can be seen in the foreground.

The cattery was constructed by a city building inspector in his spare time several years ago and cost about one thousand dollars. It has a bright, clean, colorful appearance with pine wood and pretty paint and is very easy to care for.###

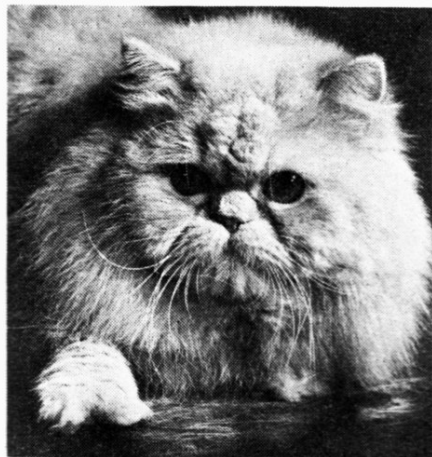

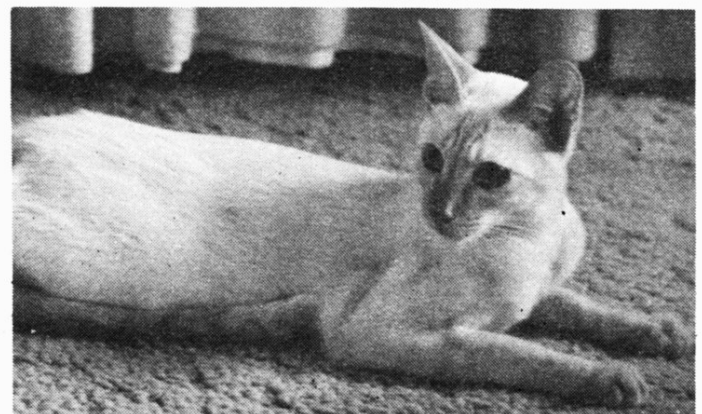

KCFA IS FORMED

As a result of a conversation I had with Mrs. Jean Johnson, owner of *NARA* and *DARRA*, in Oregon, I made contact with an ever-widening circle of Korat owners and breeders and discussions began regarding the possibility of starting a breed society for the Korat. An initial mailing, dated May 26, 1965, was sent to a preliminary list of 26 owners and breeders in U.S.A. and Canada, all that were known to be working with the breed at that time. Each one was invited to join the breed society and to send in full descriptions of their own Korats and any other Korat they had ever seen with a view to producing an appropriate standard for the breed. We wanted this to be written by the Korat breeders. From the replies we received, using the CFA "Outline for necessary information", a draft standard was compiled by Ray and Doris Gardner and myself.

The first Draft and its successors were sent to each member of the new society and to

each Board member. Everyone was asked to comment and vote. Meanwhile, we were all taking our cats and the drafts to many shows, seminars, teas, judging schools and exhibits and were soliciting the advice and guidance of the judges.

Great courtesy was extended to the Gardners and myself at a judging school in South Pasadena, California, which was presided over by Mrs. Pat Johnston, the highly respected CFA judge, who allowed us plenty of time to go over our draft standard point by point with the cats we had brought with us. In those days, the only place the Korat had at the shows was "On Exhibition Only" and it didn't seem possible that one day Pat Johnston would award Best Cat In Show to a Korat, *GRAND & QUAD CH. MALAID'S DOKLAO NOI OF SI SAWAT (IMP.)*, bred by Mr. Sunti Sriskoon of Bangkok!

Founder members of Korat Cat Fanciers Association, in addition to the Gardners and myself, included: Bertha M. Nuttall, Indiana (Ab-Hi-Ko); Elsie Ganci, Louisiana (Thai-El Gai); Mr. & Mrs. David R. Tweet, N. Carolina; Mr. and Mrs. John W. Fry and their daughter, Claire Dodds (Royale Swan), working with Jean Johnson (Cedar Glen) in the N.W.; Mrs. Jeanne Duncan; Hannah M. Douglas (Armagh-Breague) and Isobel M. Hutchison, both of Canada; and Mrs. Gertrude Gecking (now Sellars), North Olmsted, Ohio, who had visited Bangkok and the catteries of Col. Chompoo and Mme. Rajamaitri who cooperated in their breeding programs. Mrs. Gecking owned a lovely little female Korat, *ME-LUK OF TRU-LU*, born October 14, 1963. *ME-LUK* and *CEDAR GLEN'S CHUACHAI*, purchased from Jean Johnson, were the foundation of her line. Earnestly pioneering the breed, too, was Miss Marie E. Purdy, Maryland, though her plans for the Korats did not coincide with ours in some aspects.

So, later in 1965, we had progressed to the point where we had a Board of Directors, Founder Members, a Draft Constitution, a name and a slogan: "For the protection and development of the Korat Cat" (later we added to this "a native of Thailand."), and a proposed standard which had finally been shaped to the satisfaction of the Korat owners and was specific enough to represent our cats but not so rigid that it eliminated our cats' chances at the shows.

KCFA PLEDGES

One of our earliest members, Mrs. Frances Tweet, made two important and abiding proposals: that the Korat head should be stated in our judging standard to be "heartshape"; and that in our slogan "Protection" should precede "Development" in priority.

For the protection of our Korats, we formulated certain Pledges: the Membership Pledge, the Sales Pledge, and the Contract governing sale of a pet quality Korat, as well as the Minimum Prices for National Sale of Korat Cats.

We started a private listing of Korats imported, born in North America or placed,

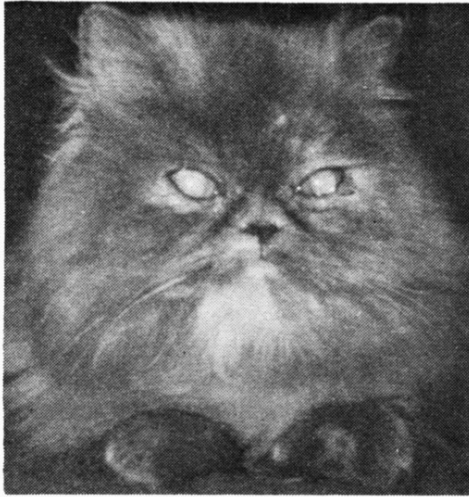

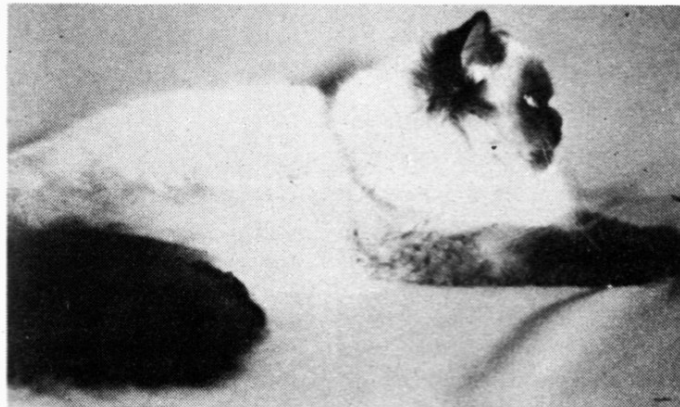

PROPOSED STANDARD FOR THE KORAT CAT
October 15th, 1965

Color: 20 Body & Tail: 25
Head (inc. ear set & placement): 20
Eyes--Shape & placement: 15; Color: 5
Coat: 10 Condition: 5 Total: 100

HEAD: When viewed from the front, head is heartshaped with breadth between and across the eyes, gently curving to a well developed but not sharply pointed muzzle. Forehead large, flat. In the male there is an indentation in the center of the forehead which accentuates this heartshaped appearance. Strong chin and jaw. In profile there is a slight stop between forehead and nose. Nose is short and has a slight downward curve. Ears are large, with a rounded tip and large flare at base, set high on head, giving an alert expression. Inside ears sparsely furnished. Broad head, 5; profile 6; breadth between eyes, 4; ear set and placement, 5.

BODY & TAIL: The Korat is medium in size with a strong muscular semi-cobby body, medium bone structure. The back is carried in a curve. Legs are well proportioned to body; feet oval. The tail is medium in length, heavier at the base, tapering to a rounded tip. No penalty for imperfect tail. Body, 15; legs & feet, 5, tail, 5.

COLOR: Blue over all, tipped with silver, the more silver the better, without shading or tabby markings. Where the coat is short the sheen of the silver is intensified. Paw pads dark blue ranging to lavender with a pinkish tinge. Nose and lip leather is dark blue or lavender. Color, 20.

EYES: Large and luminous, are particularly prominent, wide open and oversized for the face. Eye aperture, which shows as well rounded when fully open, as an asian slant when closed or partially closed. Eye color brilliant green preferred, amber cast acceptable. Kittens and adolescents have yellow or amber to amber-green eyes. Color is not usually true until the cat is two years of age. Placement, 10; shape, 5; color, 5.

COAT: Single. Hair is short to medium in length, glossy and fine, lying close to the body. The coat over the spine is inclined to break as the cat moves. Short 4; texture, 4; close lying, 2.

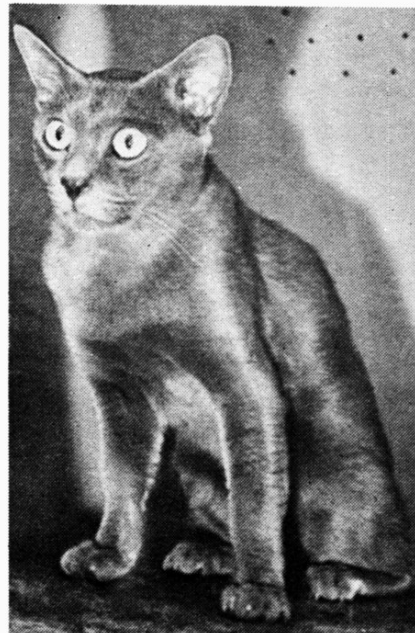
CONDITION: Perfect physical condition, muscular, alert appearance.

DEFINITION: The Korat is a recent import from Thailand. It was first found in Korat, the capital city of the north-eastern province, and so has been identified by this name. The Korat is a rare cat even in its country of origin and, because of its unusually fine disposition, is greatly loved by the Thai people who regard it as a "good luck" cat. Its general appearance is of a solid blue cat with a heavy silver sheen, medium sized, muscular, with smooth, curved lines and huge, prominent, luminous green or amber-green eyes, alert and expressive. The Korat is silver blue from birth to death. It can exist in no other color. If any other color should occur, it would automatically cease to be a Korat.

from which Jean Clark began a "Preliminary Breeding Chart". We have maintained this project by means of our "Census Forms" which Korat owners are asked to fill out. The information on these helps in the advantageous placing of our bloodlines. We insist on being able to trace a cat's ancestry back to Thailand - native land of the Korat - and our Census Forms help us do this.

All imported Korats come with more papers than you and I; there are rabies and enteritis vaccination certificates issued by veterinarians in Thailand, the Air Waybill, or Ship's Manifest, the Customs Receipt at Port of Entry, and the pedigrees from Thai breeders. No wonder the Korat is known as "The Cat With the Passport"! Just as a cat that is not silver blue is not a Korat, or Si-Sawat, a cat whose ancestry cannot be traced back to Thailand is not a Korat. There are silver blue cats all over the world. The Korat is the silver blue cat of Thailand and it is less than probable, due to our Protection policy, that "Smokey" who wandered in one day and adopted the family has any claim to Korat ancestry.

We soon learned that there were a few persons who had deliberately applied for registration of cats that had no proof of origin in Thailand, thus bringing about a risk of our native Korats getting involved with such cats and causing the birth of hybrid kittens. We refer to such cats as "A.B.C.'s" or "Any Blue Cats" and their breeders' names and cattery names are added to our "Not recommended" list which is published in every issue of KCFA's newsletter, "Mai Pen Rai". We do this to try to prevent the inevitable result: heartbreak for those who have been led to believe that they have purchased a bona fide Korat, and the lowering of the value of the Korat in the eyes of those who revere truth and honesty. We don't want any cat to suffer because we have failed to offer protection. In my early correspondence with our registering associations about these "A.B.C." cats, the problem was, in the main, given due

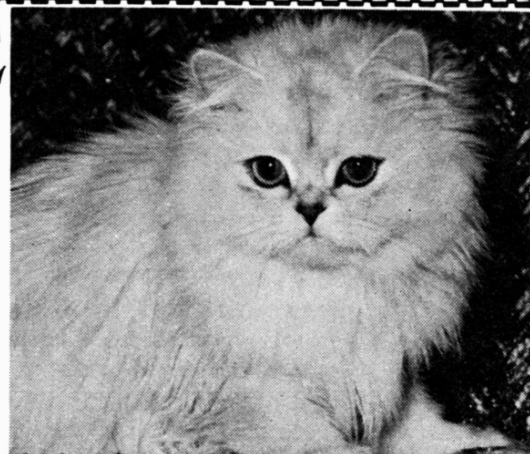
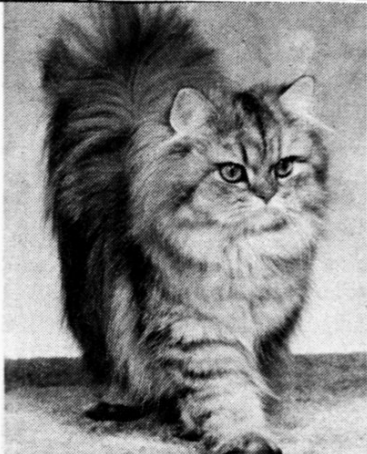

respect and understanding, and a promise to observe the need for the specified import papers was forthcoming.

Of our Pledges, the KCFA Membership Pledge reaches out perhaps the most to protect the breed. Members pledge:

1. I will do my best to protect the Korat breed.
2. I will abide by the promises in the KCFA Contract Pledge at all times, and all advertising, both verbal and written, shall be factual and honest.
3. I will abide by the terms of the KCFA Contract governing the sale of a pet Korat. A pet Korat is one which does not evidence good show potential, having faults defined in the Standard for the Korat cat.
4. I will not sell Korat cats, or provide stud service, at less than the terms set out in the KCFA Basic Minimum Price List.
5. I guarantee that I will represent all Korat cats accurately and fully and that I will breed my Korats only with Korats whose origin can be traced to Thailand.
6. Any overt act by a Member which shall in any way deter the progress and welfare of the Korat cats, or of this Association which represents them shall be considered a misdemeanor, sufficient to terminate the offender's Membership. Upon receipt of a Formal Complaint, the Board of Directors shall hear the complaint and its decision will be final.

Name of Korat owned is given and Pledge must bear Member's signature and that of sponsoring Member. Though perhaps not binding in a Court of Law, this Pledge, we feel, adds to our cat's chances if only because the owner has been willing to sign.

In signing the KCFA Sales Contract, the buyer of a Korat pledges:

I, new Owner/Buyer of the above described Korat, promise faithfully that:

Should it for any reason become impossible for me to keep him/her, I will undertake so

to advise the breeder/seller named above; I will not sell or give away this Korat without the knowledge and consent of the above; will not allow him/her to run loose unprotected; I will never deal with my Korat(s) through a pet shop or animal dealer; I will never purchase or use for breeding a so-called "Korat" whose ancestry cannot be traced to Thailand; I will never permit breeding of my Korat(s) with another breed with intent to represent the offspring as Korats; I will maintain the good health and condition of this Korat, and give him/her a happy life; all Korats born as a result of the mating of this Korat will be sold/placed per the terms of this Contract/Pledge; I will not have him/her declawed.

If the new owner is acquiring a pet Korat, the Pledge continues:

I will have him/her neutered/spayed by a registered veterinarian when he/she is _____ months of age. When this operation has been performed, I will send to Breeder/Seller a certificate from the veterinarian to that effect, giving date of operation. The buyer is advised on the form that a pet quality Korat, having faults as defined in the Standard may be initially registered as a Neuter/Spay.

On the same form, the Breeder/Seller of the Korat guarantees that he/she: is of proven Thai ancestry; is sold exactly as represented in all aspects of health, temperament and quality; has been examined by a veterinarian and found to be free of worms, fleas, earmites and fungus as of (date); has been fully immunized against Feline Infectious Enteritis as of (dates of shots) with (type of vaccine); has been handled with love since birth.

For the pet Korat, the breeder/seller further pledges to provide his/her pedigree and registration number upon receipt of the veterinarian's certificate of altering.###
