Female 1: 1 Curtis-Hayward's Petsamo Silver Swanhilda, glorious eye-colour, coat too long, too cobby in type, ears too small, again too British in type, nice even blue colouring. Kitten: 1 Petre's Broadweir Blue Catkin, head too round, eyes pale, ears on top of head with insufficient width between, too British in type, but may improve later. AOV Cat: 1 Dell's Kupro Cream Kismet, Cream foreign type, evenly marked and attractive colour, very pretty cat indeed. 2 Curtis-Hayward's Tarawood Aquamarine, Blue-cream foreign type, insufficiently mingled, coat a bit long for shorthair and on the plump side. Kitten: 1 Pike's Lydeard Jonquil, baby Burmese, fair type, very sweet, eyes too pale. 2 Redmill's Cio-San Liu, Blue-Cream colouring, nice soft coat. 3 McConnell's Golden Shiloh Boy, Cream colouring, foreign type, tail barred, bars on back, coat open and eyes greenish in colour. HAVANA Cat: 1 ch Waite's Southview Duaeobony, excellent type, head could be a trifle longer and eye colour could be greener, lovely soft close silky coat of good dense brown colouring, very elegant pleasing exhibit. 2 Sayer's Ch Dandyat Zulu Warrior,

excellent type with very good long head, eyes could be deeper, out of condition today which puts him down, scruffy coat and too thin Kitten: 1 Sayer's Solitaire Pikako, beautiful kitten of lovely type, good head, eyes could be deeper, nice fine coat of good colour, should improve and do well later. SMOKE Cat male 3: 1 ch Sykes's Starbourne Pioneer, this cat is all male, he has wonderful bone formation, has a very good head, lovely strong muzzle and chin, a nice broad nose, large round eyes of deep copper, his coat is long and flowing and groomed to perfection, his contrasts are very good, he has a lovely white undercoat, a good mask and excellent silver ear tufts, add to all this a very short full brush, he is a credit to his owners, he was my nomination for best LH Cat. 2 Nichols's Sonata Tempo, another very good cat, good coat for contrasts, but mask showing little white marks on brow, lovely deep copper eyes, very good head and type, coat not so full as winners, but having a lovely silver fluff, this cat is very young, not yet a year old so should think would do very well when fully matured. 3 Collins's Kala Kavalier, wonderful cat for head and type, but eyes rather pale and one was running when I judged him, his coat was full, but his top coat was rather rusty, the beauty of a Smoke is a black top coat with a white undercoat and although his type is so good he had to go down on coat. Female 2: 1 ch Nichols's Miz-Pah Samantha, a lovely queen, excellent coat and contrasts, lovely head and type, large round deep copper eyes, tail just a little long, I called in another judge to sign for a second CC as the quality of both male and female were so good. 2 Nichols's Mizpah Tabitha, a Blue Smoke, coat much too blue at present, lovely eyes for shape and colour, very good head, but would like a shorter nose, nice full ruff. SILVER TABBY Cat 3: 1 ch Light's Ch Karnak Mailoc, quite a good one, head and legs well marked, good head and type, his colouring is quite good also eye colour. 2 Young's Wilmar Willeen, not so good as the

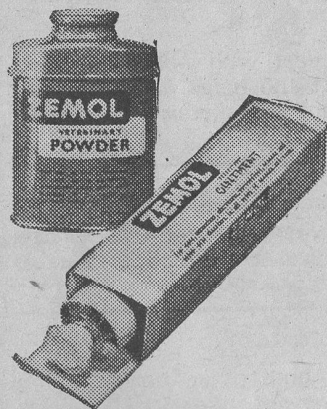
male, her coat lacks stripes at present and her tail is very thin, she has a sweet expression and very good eye colour. Nothing I could say would be adequate to express my gratitude to Frank and Brenda Wolstenholme. No one has ever worked harder or been so determined that a show was going to be a success.

It was a great disappointment that Mr and Mrs Lamb, Mrs Shrouder and Miss Grainger were not able to be with us and we were most grateful to Mrs Merry and Mrs Denny for coming so willingly at the last moment, and to all the judges and stewards who worked so hard and so cheerfully.

Finally our thanks must go to all the lovely cats and their owners, we hope you enjoyed the show, and we look forward to seeing you all again next year. ANNE RICKSON

**SMOKE Male 1:** 1 ch Hoyle's Ch Hardendale Nicholas, a truly lovely Smoke and too well known to think of anything new to say about him, he was looking particularly good today, lovely black silky top coat with good contrasting ashen undercoat, short sturdy black legs and good brush, good broad head, round copper eyes, neat ears with good silver ear tufts, short snub nose and good black mask, he well deserves his many successes and must be the unbeaten Smoke of the last two if not three years, a true Smoke. Female 4: 1 White's Joyda Scherazade, a nice Smoke but not nearly enough contrast between her good ash undercoat and rather light top coat which was showing too many white hairs, brilliant round orange eyes, neat ears with good silver ear tufts, good chin, nose a little long, nice silver ruff, fairly good mask but not dark enough in contrast, good brush and profuse well groomed coat, I did not give her a ch certificate as a Smoke must have a good contrast between his as black as possible top coat and his ash or silver undercoat, between his black as possible mask and his ash or silver ruff—to be a Smoke 2. Everington's Sonata Chiarezza, very pretty little blue Smoke, blue mask and top coat, nice silver undercoat and good silver ruff, well shaped head, nice eyes in shape and colour, ears rather large and outlined in black, so must have had a Chinchilla background. 3 Hoyle's Hardendale Nicolette, here we have a very dark Smoke with not sufficient contrast between good black top coat and blue undercoat, good head, good black mask, lovely eyes in shape and colour, short nose, neat ears, good chin, good brush. 4 Bewley's Bianca Arabesque Kitten 2: 1 Hoyle's Hardendale Tabriz, a little gem, really lovely Smoke kitten, my nomination for best in show which he won, and well deserved, beautiful head, lovely type, round copper eyes, short snub nose, good chin, nice silver ruff and silver ear tufts, good mask and top coat for his age, with good silver contrasts coming through well, Nicholas's son by his mother who will make his mark in future shows. 2 Wright's Wigtell Khood, huge kitten, profuse coat, well shaped head, round copper eyes, neat well tufted ears, good mask, nice black stockings, nice brush. **CHINCHILLA Ad male:** 1 Roberts's Polar Valerio, very nice with striking blue-green eyes, good pink nose, good broad head, good chin and well ticked profuse coat, fairly evenly ticked, rather dark on tail, just spoilt by a large yellow bib on his lovely ruff just under his chin, his owner says he dips it in his custard and it is permanently stained, I did not feel I could give him a ch certificate as it was so noticeable and quite spoilt the whole effect. 2 Clark's Bianca Mischka, another nice male but very nervous and difficult to handle, I judged him when he was being held with gloves on by another judge and did not take him out of his cage again as he was in such a state, good broad head, good pink nose but rather long and straight, lovely green eyes, profuse well ticked coat, well groomed. 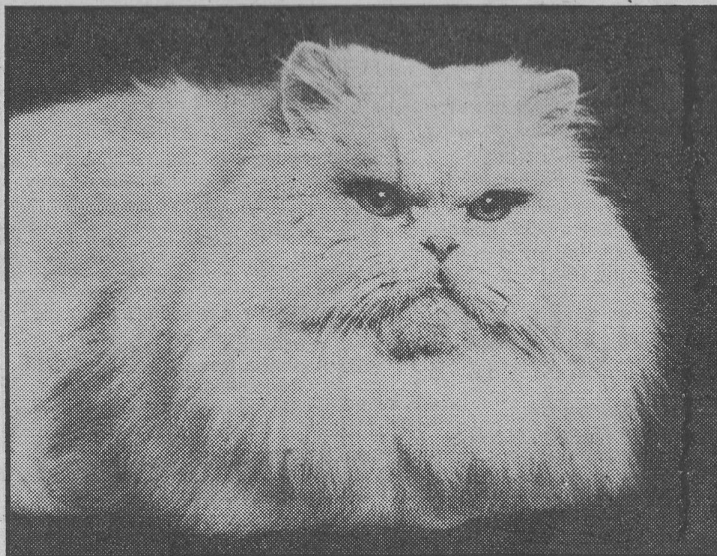

One of them, after lunch, badly bit another judge and I think this raises the question as to whether it is fair and reasonable to expect highly sexed full male cats to be safely handleable in the afternoon after being subjected to the noise, smell of other cats and sight of them being handled, and the effect of their next door neighbours for several hours. 1 ch Laurent's Dinham George, a fine large young cat who is a good typical example of the breed, coat quality and colour is excellent, a good head with well set ears and quite nice eye colour, a really well balanced cat 2 Winder's Ch Peerless Sukova, a large cat, rather dark in colour but very good for type, apart from a tendency to jowliness, which could be expected at his age, his head and face is good, his eye colour is a little pale 3 Bentinck's Coppelston Chinga, another young cat of good type but with a rather pale coat at present which shows some tabby bars, slightly overlong, squarish muzzle tends to spoil his face r Smith's Ch Magamba Satan, large cat but rather fine boned, which was emphasised by a tendency to thinness, this makes him appear at present rather unbalanced, nice head, tail rather pointed Female 14: I found this a very disappointing class, many of the cats were in my opinion too small and too fine boned for typical Burmese 1 ch Winder's Peerless Sarona, medium size, nicely balanced cat, excellent quality and colour of coat, very good type with a correct tail, nice head and above average eye colour 2 Bentley's Bosinver Ma Chow, of good size and type and with very good coat texture and colour, good head, fair eye colour, worst fault is a rather short and pointed tail 3 Threadingham's Ch Bernina Princess Isis, medium size, tendency to fine bone and therefore not such good type and first and second, very nice coat and good eyes r Davis's Lochibank Tania, small to medium size and rather fine boned, nice coat and good head, showing one or two white hairs on chest. At the time I judged the Blue Burmese the light in the hall was not very good, which made it rather difficult to assess coat colour of the Blues **BLUE BURMESE** Male 7: 1 ch Dixon's Kalos Blue Admetus, large cat, well balanced and of good Burmese type, nice silvery colour, free from sandiness, very nice head with well-set ears, eyes a good yellow (greenish rather than golden) 2 Armstrong's Ch Belcanto La Favorita, good type large cat, in many ways similar to the winner but I thought not so well balanced, he seems to have very slight bend in his tail near the tip 3 Osborne's Montana Blue Shadow, medium size cat, good coat colour, nice head, eye colour rather pale Female 6: 1 ch withheld, Berry's Navron Blue Zuleika, medium size, good coat colour, good Burmese type and a very nice head, very nice cat but unfortunately with a short tail, for this reason I could not regard her as a typical Burmese cat and therefore withheld the CC, her short tail is unlikely to affect her breeding performance. Of the remaining three cats all were over-typed, ie too fine boned and leaning towards Siamese, and two were too small, so this was not a very rewarding class 2 Osborne's Bybrook Honey Child, medium size, nice coat colour, moderately good head and eye colour, short pointed tail 3 Skalder's Ramree Fatima, small, fairly good coat colour and with a long, whip tail which is incorrect for Burmese 4 Eustace's Golightly Sabba, generally rather similar to third but with rather less good eye colour

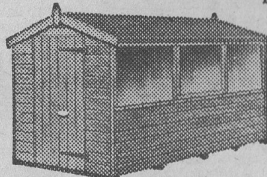

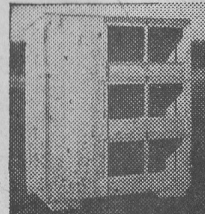

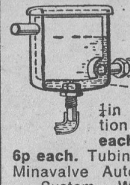
